WHY DO WE DO THAT? CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question: If a person is dying and wants the last rites, may a layperson say a prayer and have it be the same?

Answer: While a layperson could say prayers and bring Communion to someone at the point of death, a layperson cannot validly administer the last rites. The last rites involve anointing with holy oil and the absolution of sins, and only a validly ordained priest can administer that sacrament.


