VISITATION'S MUSIC PROGRAM

All students are given the opportunity to perform in a yearly Christmas musical and a Spring musical.
Students in grades 5th-8th grade have an opportunity to participate in choir on Tuesdays and Thursdays, after school.



OVERALL GOALS:

- Become fully literate in the language of music, including both sight reading and notation
- Learn to sing and to recognize the concepts of pitch and tuning as they apply to singing
- Listen to, analyze, and evaluate various genres of music
- Learn the basic eras of music history and he characteristics that distinguish them
- Participate in musical activities that revolve around music of varying cultures
- Participate in performances and learn basic theater skills
- Be able to integrate music with other subjects

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Visitation Catholic School is dedicated to the four-fold principles of Catholic education: message, service, community and worship. In accordance with these purposes, we are committed to the building of a Christ centered community of students. We believe all who participate in the process have vital and distinct roles.



KINDERGARTEN - 2ND GRADE

- Learn to match pitch and recognize a basic beat
- Begin to understand the difference between beat and rhythm
- Learn the different instrument families and recognize instruments by sound
- Prepare and perform in the Christmas and Spring musicals

3RD GRADE - 5TH GRADE

- Demonstrate the ability to perform a rhythm while maintaining a steady beat. Learn to sing more musically, actively employing the concepts of dynamic, musical punctuation and appropriate tempo
- Learn to perform on instruments as an ensemble with contrasting parts
- Fourth graders will learn to play the recorder in the spring. Fourth and fifth graders participate in basic composition projects
- Understand music in relation to history and varying cultures

- Prepare and perform in the Christmas and Spring musical

6TH GRADE - 8TH GRADE

- Listen and analyze music on a complex level
- Read and notate music.
- Compose music, including the Spring musical composition project for the 7th and 8th grade classes
- Demonstrate knowledge of basic stage terminology
- Participate in the school choir
- Demonstrate ability to perform both independently and corporately in a musical ensemble
