LANGUAGE ARTS

READING

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Visitation Catholic School is dedicated to the four-fold principles of Catholic education: message, service, community and worship. In accordance with these principles, we are committed to the building of a Christ centered community of students. We believe all who participate in the process have vital and distinct roles.



MATHEMATICS

- Order, model, and compare common whole numbers, fractions, decimals and percentages
- Add, subtract, multiply, and divide whole numbers, decimals, fractions and percentages
- Determine the order of operations for multiple step calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division
- Measure length, weight, perimeter, area, and volume with accuracy using the appropriate tools
- Define, draw, name, and classify angles, triangles, and line segments using measurement tools
- Represent and analyze patterns and functions using words, tablets, graphs or simple algebraic expressions

SCIENCE

- Use the scientific method to explore, experiment, and inquire about the natural world
- Investigate plants, invertebrates, vertebrates, and communities
- Discover the building blocks of matter and sources of energy
- Discover the Earth and universe including changes in weather



RELIGION

- Study of the New Testament, sacraments, liturgy, prayers, and service
