



The Pastor's Corner:

The Pentecost readings celebrate our wealth of resources in the Church, gifts that increase as they are given away. Luke's writings, in the Acts of the Apostles, make clear that the gift of the Spirit is not a personal privilege. The coming of the Paraclete signals the start of a worldwide mission impelling the early Christians beyond their geographic boundaries. The Good News must be announced to all the nations. Pentecost bestowed on the Church the Spirit's gift of unity. Paul, in the second reading, explains this gift to the divided church of Corinth. Using the metaphor of the body, Paul observes that there are many members, but only one body. The whole body suffers when the members war against one another. Rivalry in the Christian community is wrong because we are members of the one Body of Christ, each of us has received the one Spirit.

The Spirit's gifts are many: teaching, instructing, healing, consoling, forgiving, encouraging, and so forth. Pentecost challenges all believers to identify their unique talent so as to share that resource with the deprived. The Spirit will increase our gifts to the extent that we give them away.
