
TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SEPTEMBER 11, 2022

Saturday, September 24th, from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm, at St. Joseph's Church in Owatonna, and virtually, via Zoom. Our speakers will be Emily Zanon from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA), Jeff Broburg from the Minnesota Well Owners Organization (MNWOO), and Terry Janis from the Niibi Center. Emily will speak about the role of the MPCA in identifying pollutants and mitigating their presence in our state's watersheds. PASTOR'S CORNER

All three scripture readings for our weekend Masses confront sinfulness: Israel sinfully worshiping the golden calf. Paul confessing his former blasphemy and arrogance, and the scribes and Pharisees murmuring that Jesus welcomes sinners and eats with them. Exodus tells of the Israelites' impatience with Moses' prolonged absence on Mount Sinai. Angry at God, they persuade Aaron to make them another god, the golden calf. An emotionally charged bargaining session follows. Moses presents reasons why Yahweh should not destroy this "stiff-necked people": They are Yahweh's people; the Egyptians would mock a God who destroyed the very people God had just saved; destruction would break God's own promise of a great nation and many descendants.

God's mercy is bestowed, the same mercy that is highlighted in the second reading. Paul speaks of the great sinner he was before his conversion; yet in Jesus, he received overflowing grace. Paul is an example for every Christian. Conversion is Christ's doing, not ours. It is an ongoing process rather than something completed at baptism. If there had been any doubt about God's patience, there can be none remaining with the gift of Jesus as Savior.

When the gospel says there is more joy in heaven over one repentant sinner than over ninety-nine righteous persons, it does not mean we might as well go out and sin. The point is that those who are ever faithful to the Lord experience a joy that overflows onto the one returning from the exile of sin. This is the heart of the gospel of Jesus: those lost and found, those strayed and returned, those who have sinned and been forgiven.

I hope to see many of you at St. Anthony's Fall Bazaar this Sunday for dinner and activities. Our fall festivals are always a wonderful time to enjoy each other's company. Next weekend, (9/18) is St. Adrian's Fall Bazaar. Besides the day's dinner and activities, Fr. Jason Kern, the Vocation Director of our diocese with be with us for the festivities. Fr. Jason was with me in Winona at the Cathedral, and it will be wonderful to have him here to share about vocations.
