#### **GENERAL BAPTISM REQUIREMENTS**

<u>ALL</u> required paperwork must be completed, returned and verified before a baptism will be scheduled. If paperwork is missing and not returned at least 1 week prior to the requested date, we will be unable to schedule the baptism. All baptisms <u>MUST</u> be scheduled and confirmed with Veronica Santillan. Paperwork may be faxed, emailed or brought to the pastoral center. The following is required to schedule a baptism:

- 1. Packet with top portion completed.
- 2. Certified copy of child's birth certificate (MUST be a state issued birth certificate); a copy can be made at the Pastoral Center if necessary.
- 3. Blue Baptism information form completely filled out (parent & godparent info).
- 4. Baptism Request Form filled out (if requesting a specific date).
- 5. Any permission letters needed (may be emailed or faxed but original with parish seal and pastor's signature will need to be mailed or dropped off).
- 6. Any Baptism class completion certificates or completion letters.
- 7. Godparent affidavits, filled out and signed. Also, Confirmation certificate for each and Marriage certificate if applicable.
- 8. \$10 paperwork fee (per baptism packet, 1 child = \$10, 2 children = \$20, etc.) will need to be paid when packet is submitted.

#### \*\*\*This fee is NOT for the Sacrament of Baptism, but for the paperwork and baptismal candle.\*\*\*

If the parent(s) of child to be are not registered members of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, they must obtain a permission letter from their parish that is signed, dated and stamped with the parish seal. This letter must state that they have permission to baptize their child outside of their parish. If submitting a copy electronically, parish seal must be visible.

Older children (7+) needing the Sacrament of Baptism must attend special classes designed for baptism preparation through the Religious Education Department. Contact Sr. Katrina Ruane at 210-651-6913 or katrinruane@gmail.com for more information.

#### **GODPARENT INFORMATION**

• Godparent(s) requirements and duties are as follows: **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE** 

#### Minimum requirements according to CANON LAW 873 & 874

- 1. Only one (1) Godparent is required, but if there are two (2), one must be male and one must be female.
- 2. MUST be practicing Catholic at least 16 years old who has received Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation (copy of Confirmation certificate required)
- 3. If married, MUST be married in the Catholic Church (copy of marriage certificate required)
- 4. Leads a life in harmony with the faith and leads a life in harmony with the role to be undertaken.
- 5. A baptized person who belongs to a Non-Catholic Christian community may be a witness but only with a Catholic Godparent (Catholics who do not have all of their sacraments do **NOT** qualify).
- Baptism Class is required if a class has not been completed in the last five (5) years.
- Each Godparent must fill out, sign and date the affidavit.
- If Godparent's are not registered members of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, they must obtain permission letter from their parish that is signed, dated and stamped with the parish seal. This letter must state that they are members in good standing and have permission to be a sponsor (godparent) outside of their parish. Letters may be faxed or emailed as long as parish seal is visible.

#### **BAPTISM CLASS INFORMATION**

A baptism class is required for parents and godparents if a class has not been completed in the last five (5) years.

Baptism class my be completed at another parish, but a certificate or letter of completion from the parish where the class was taken must be turned in. The Archdiocese of San Antonio does **NOT** recognize on-line courses for baptism.

Classes at OLPH are held the second (2nd) Monday of the month (if scheduling allows) at 6:30pm and last approximately 1 1/2 hours. Due to classroom size, attendance **IS limited**. You **must** be registered to attend the class. To register, you can do so on our website or by calling into the office.

\*\*\*CLASS DATES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE\*\*\*

Baptisms are scheduled on Saturdays at 10am with a Deacon. Saturday/Sunday options during Mass have to be cleared by the Pastor. (this option is not available during the seasons of Lent and Advent)

#### GENERAL BAPTISM SCHEDULING INFORMATION

- All baptisms will be scheduled on a first come first serve basis.
- Your child's baptism <u>will not</u> be scheduled unless all paperwork is turned in and verified by Veronica Santillan in the Pastoral Center.
- Once all required paperwork is received and verified, you will receive a confirmation email with your child's baptism date and time. Your child's baptism date and time will not be reserved until you receive this confirmation.
- Baptism time and date availability will vary depending on church schedule and deacon schedule and they are subject to change.

#### **BAPTISM OPTIONS**

- Saturdays at 10am with a Deacon (no Mass)
- Saturday or Sunday within Mass (*MUST be cleared and approved by Pastor*) (this option is not available during the seasons of Lent and Advent)
