



THE PIZZA GUY

GOD HAS INFINITE TTENTION TO SPARE OR EACH ONE OF US. YOU ARE AS MUCH ALONE WITH HIM AS IF YOU WERE THE ONLY BEING HE HAD EVER CREATED

Thomas Monaghan is a businessman who has made a fortune through a hugely successful chain of pizza stores. Brought up in an orphanage, he once thought the accumulation of expensive possessions was justifiable, even necessary. Yet, in reading Mere Christianity by the noted author C. S. Lewis, Monaghan realized that the root motivation beneath his love for wealth and show was the need to impress others, which is a form of pride. Released from the hold that possessions once exercised over his heart, Monaghan simplified his life—no private jet, no fancy cars, no huge mansion—and now experiences joy in giving to causes that further Christ's kingdom. A few years ago he described his new understanding of stewardship and discipleship. He said that people think that he is making huge sacrifices, but he believes that they do not understand giving. He credits God for everything he has, so any money he has is also God's. Yes, he certainly had to work hard, but where did the enthusiasm, the energy, the willpower and persistence to work hard come from? From God. Monaghan is convinced that he has no right to credit himself for abilities and skills that came from God. So whatever he has produced with those talents is not ultimately his: it all belongs to God. So, Monaghan says that his motivation for the so-called sacrifices he makes is blindingly obvious. He was brought up with this belief that the true value of life is to get to heaven while dragging along as many people as he can with him! He is always taken aback when people refer to him as a devout Catholic for sharing so much wealth. Lewis, Monaghan se dio cuenta de que la causa de su motivación para amar y mostrar sus riquezas era la necesidad de impresionar a los demás, lo cual es una forma de orgullo. Una vez que quedó libre de las ataduras que las riquezas ponían en su corazón, Monaghan simplificó su vida no avión privado, no coches de lujo, ni mansión enorme—y ahora goza con contribuir a aquellas causas que edifican el reino de Cristo. Hace unos años él describió su nuevo entendimiento de lo que quiere decir corresponsabilidad y discipulado. Dijo que la gente pensaba que él estaba haciendo grandes sacrificios, pero que la gente no entiende en qué consiste el dar. Él atribuye a Dios todo lo que tiene, de ahí que cualquier dinero que él tenga también es de Dios. Sí, es cierto que tuvo que trabajar duro, pero ¿de dónde vinieron el entusiasmo, la energía, la voluntad y la perseverancia para trabajar? Todo vino de Dios. Monaghan está convencido de que él no tiene derecho a adjudicarse ningún derecho o crédito por unas habilidades y aptitudes que han venido de Dios; por tanto, nada de lo que haya producido con esos talentos le pertenece, sino que todo es de Dios. Monaghan añade que, como consecuencia, su motivación para hacer esos supuestos sacrificios debe saltar a la vista de cualquiera. Todo esto lo ha llevado a creer que el verdadero valor de la vida consiste en ponerse en camino al cielo jy llevar consigo a tantos como pueda! Siempre le sorprende cuando la gente se refiere a él como un católico muy devoto por compartir tanta riqueza. Aunque se siente muy halagado, dice que es demasiado pecador para merecer tal elogio. 

Teaching mercy to children

Partners in Faith



Pope Francis recently said, "Jesus' attitude is striking: we do not hear the words of scorn, we do not hear words of condemnation, but only words of love, of mercy ..." As followers of Jesus, we want our children to speak and live with love and mercy. One way to do this is to teach children compassion. Try these ideas

Exercise patience with your children.

Compassion and mercy are learned behaviors.
Being a loving, patient parent and modeling those qualities will go a long way toward raising kind, compassionate adults.

Reduce exposure to violence in games, television shows, and movies. Credible studies show that exposure to violence increases aggressive behavior. Discourage exposure to violent entertainment. Instead, remind children that hurting and humiliating others isn't ever cool, funny, or interesting.

Coach children to notice people's facial expressions. This is the first step in learning how to understand another's perspective.

Practice "The 180." When your child is angry with a friend or classmate, help him think of all the reasons why she might have done the offending action. It doesn't excuse the behavior but it makes forgiveness easier.

Love unconditionally. A child who has never felt accepted or unconditionally loved by her family can be so preoccupied by her own needs that she is deaf to the cries of others in need.




