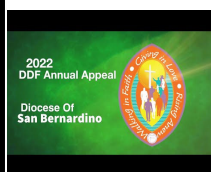

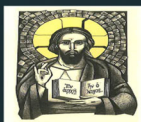

Jesus, help us to listen to and follow the voice of the Holy Spirit that leads us to do what is good and true.

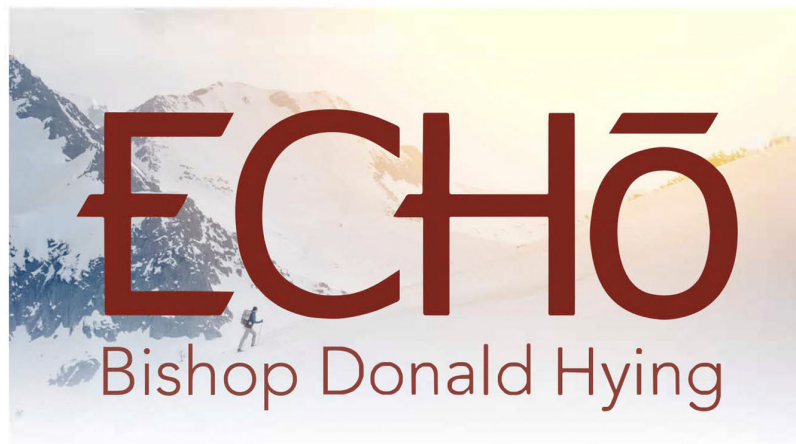

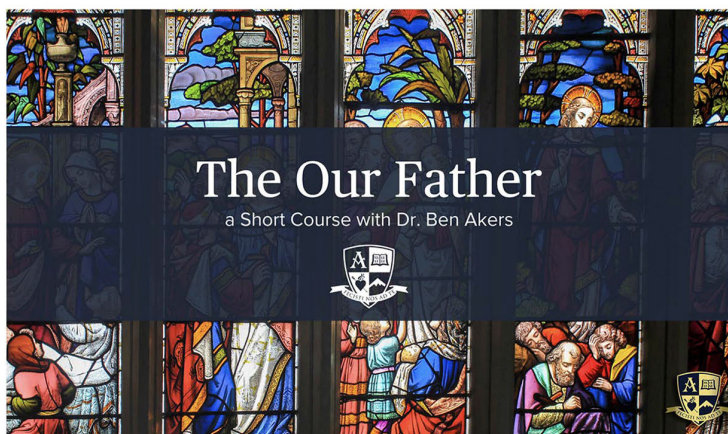

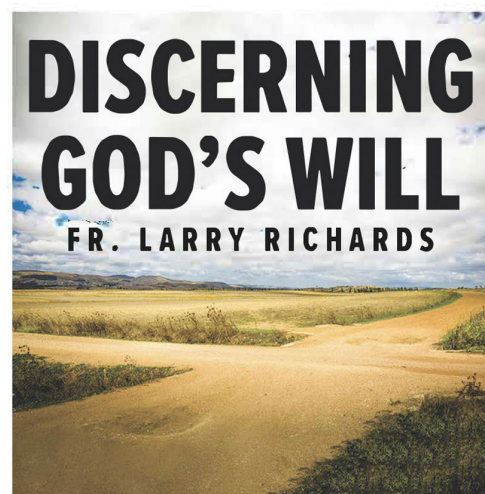
