
# From the Pastor

A Reflection from the Fourth Sunday of Easter

In his 2013 Chrism Mass homily, our late Pope Francis caught international attention by famously asking priests to "take on the smell of the sheep". What he meant by that rather provocative statement was this: it is the task of the shepherd to draw close to the people entrusted to his care, to accompany them in the joys and sorrows of their lives, to put aside his own needs and ambitions and, as Francis continued, "to put his own skin and heart on the line" for the sake of Christ and the Church. And he asked the laity to accompany their pastors with affection and prayer in the pastoral burdens they must carry.

But what the Holy Father called priests to "smell" like, he would repeat as a call to the laity in his encyclical "The Joy of the Gospel". Francis, in speaking about the laity's role in evangelization said, "They too must take on the smell of the sheep so that the sheep will hear and listen to their voice." Priests who put their own "skin and heart on the line" and a laity that is courageous enough to draw close to those in family, workplace, and community who do not believe or who are vulnerable and in need is how we take to ourselves this smell of the sheep and bear witness. Francis concluded with something of a warning, "...If they (the world) do not find in the Church a spirituality that heals them, frees them, fills them with life and peace while convoking them to solidarity, communion, and missionary fruitfulness, they will end up deceived by proposals that do not humanize or give glory to God."(21)

While the image of the Good Shepherd is a favorite one in Christian art, evoking images of gentleness and care, we can forget that this image was used by the Lord in a confrontation with the religious authorities of Jerusalem and, in part, directly contributed to their decision to bring about his death. The reasons for this are many, but foremost because, according to Prophet Ezekiel, God promises a day on which "I myself will shepherd my sheep".



Jesus is asserting that He is the fulfillment of this promise, that He is God in the flesh. This is a startling assertion. But perhaps most startling of all is that, in Jesus, God does not shepherd us from a distance but from among us, beside us, and as one of us, taking to Himself the "smell of the sheep" He comes to save.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd who takes to Himself the smell of the sheep. The priests He calls and the laity He sends can do no less in the sense that we cannot authentically care for our parish, community, and those who need our love and charity without "putting skin" into the game. Our witness does not have to be perfect, but it does have to be sincere and consistent if others are to encounter Jesus through us, who wills to free us and fills us with real missionary fruitfulness.

Caring for the sheep can be a messy, smelly task. But it is our task, if we are to be faithful to the command and example of Jesus, the Good Shepherd.


Una Reflexión del Cuarto Domingo de Pascua

En su homilía de la Misa Crismal de 2013, nuestro querido Papa Francisco llamó la atención internacional al pedirles a los sacerdotes que "tuvieran olor a oveja". Con esa declaración provocativa, quiso decir lo siguiente: es tarea del pastor acercarse al pueblo que se le ha confiado, acompañarlo en las alegrías y penas de su vida, dejar de lado sus propias necesidades y ambiciones y, como continuó Francisco, "jugarse la piel y el corazón" por amor a Cristo y a la Iglesia. Y pidió a los laicos que acompañaran a sus pastores con afecto y oración en las cargas pastorales que deben llevar.

Pero lo que el Santo Padre pidió a los sacerdotes que "olieran", lo repitió como llamado a los laicos en su exhortación apostólica Evangelii Gaudium ("La Alegría del Evangelio"). Francisco, al hablar sobre el papel del laicado en la evangelización, dijo: "También ellos deben tener olor a oveja para que las ovejas reconozcan su voz". Sacerdotes que se juegan la piel y el corazón, y laicos con el valor suficiente para acercarse a quienes en su familia, trabajo y comunidad no creen, o son vulnerables y están necesitados, es como asumimos ese "olor a oveja" y damos testimonio. Francisco concluyó con una especie de advertencia:

"...Si (el mundo) no encuentra en la Iglesia una espiritualidad que los sane, los libere, los llene de vida y paz, convocándolos a la solidaridad, a la comunión y a la fecundidad misionera, terminarán por dejarse engañar por propuestas que no humanizan ni dan gloria a Dios." (n. 238)

Aunque la imagen del Buen Pastor es una de las favoritas en el arte cristiano, evocando ternura y cuidado, podemos olvidar que el Señor usó esta imagen en una confrontación con las autoridades religiosas de Jerusalén y que, en parte, contribuyó directamente a la decisión de llevarlo a la muerte. Las razones son muchas, pero sobre todo porque, según el profeta Ezequiel, Dios promete un día en el que "Yo mismo apacentaré a mis ovejas".



Jesús afirma que Él es el cumplimiento de esa promesa, que Él es Dios hecho carne. Esta es una afirmación asombrosa. Pero quizás lo más asombroso es que, en Jesús, Dios no nos pastorea desde lejos, sino desde entre nosotros, a nuestro lado, y como uno de nosotros, asumiendo el "olor a oveja" de aquellos a quienes viene a salvar.

Jesús es el Buen Pastor que asume el olor de las ovejas. Los sacerdotes que Él llama y los laicos que Él envía no pueden hacer menos, en el sentido de que no podemos cuidar auténticamente a nuestra parroquia, comunidad y a quienes necesitan nuestro amor y caridad sin también "jugar la piel". Nuestro testimonio no tiene que ser perfecto, pero sí debe ser sincero y constante si otros han de encontrarse con Jesús a través de nosotros, Él que quiere liberarnos y llenarnos de verdadera fecundidad misionera.

Cuidar de las ovejas puede ser una tarea desordenada y con olor. Pero es nuestra tarea, si queremos ser fieles al mandato y al ejemplo de Jesús, el Buen Pastor.


