From the Pastor

Stewardship

On **Sunday, November 2**, we will be hosting a parish ministry fair, which will take place in the ICS cafeteria from **8:00 am to 1:00 pm**. Ministry fairs are not a new thing to parishes. They have been taking place in various ways for years. The purpose of these fairs is to highlight the diversity of pastoral life taking place in the parish and to invite people to consider how their unique experiences and gifts might contribute to advancing the parish mission. I invite you to attend.

The foundation of these events is the call to renew ourselves in faithful stewardship of the gifts we have been given. It is on stewardship that I'd like to reflect in this series of articles leading up to the ministry fair.

What is Stewardship?

When most people hear the word "*stewardship*", they tend to think of it as Catholic jargon for fundraising. While it is true that stewardship has something to say about our financial giving habits, the concept of stewardship is much broader than this.

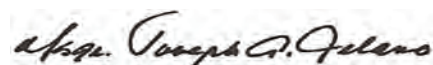
So, let's start with a "*non-theological*" definition of stewardship. Stewardship, as Merriam-Webster defines it, is "*the responsible oversight and management of something entrusted to one's care.*" Immediately, we should notice that a stewardship is a trust. It is the responsible care of someone else's goods or assets, not our own.

This same concept is seen throughout the Scripture and Catholic theology. We first encounter it in the creation stories of Genesis, in which God entrusts creation itself to the care of humanity for its own development and to the betterment of those who live within it. Jesus, too, told parables about kings going off on journeys and entrusting servants with their property, lights not hidden under bushel baskets, and masters returning "*like thieves in the night*" requiring an accounting from their stewards. St. Paul, in his epistle, talks about the manifold gifts of the Holy Spirit given to every member of the Church, the purpose of proclaiming the Gospel and building up the Church for the works of ministry. Even more examples can be given.

When understood correctly, then, stewardship is not a slogan for fundraising. Stewardship is our response to the God who has entrusted to us the very mission of Christ and the Church, giving us gifts of grace beyond measure to accomplish it and resources both temporal and spiritual to support it. The only response to this trust is humility and gratitude. This stewardship is not so much about what we do in the parish or how much we give, but why we do it in the first place. God has given generously to us, and we, in turn, are called to give back in gratitude to serve the mission.

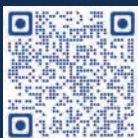

Corresponsabilidad Cristiana

Domingo, 2 de noviembre, realizaremos una feria de ministerios parroquiales en la cafetería de ICS, de 8:00 a.m. a 1:00 p.m.

Las ferias de ministerios no son algo nuevo en las parroquias; se han llevado a cabo de diversas maneras durante muchos años. El propósito de estas ferias es destacar la diversidad de la vida pastoral que se desarrolla en la parroquia e invitar a las personas a considerar cómo sus dones y experiencias únicas pueden contribuir al crecimiento de la misión parroquial. Los invito cordialmente a participar.

La base de estos eventos es el llamado a renovarnos en la corresponsabilidad fiel de los dones que hemos recibido. En esta serie de artículos, que nos conducen a la feria de ministerios, me gustaría reflexionar precisamente sobre la corresponsabilidad cristiana.

¿Qué es la Corresponsabilidad?

Cuando la mayoría de las personas escuchan la palabra "corresponsabilidad" (o stewardship), suelen pensar que se trata de un término católico que significa "recaudación de fondos". Si bien es cierto que la corresponsabilidad tiene algo que decir sobre nuestros hábitos de donación económica, su significado es mucho más amplio. Comencemos con una definición "no teológica" de corresponsabilidad.

Según el diccionario Merriam-Webster, stewardship se define como "la supervisión y administración responsable de algo que se ha confiado a nuestro cuidado". De inmediato debemos notar que la corresponsabilidad es una confianza: el cuidado responsable de los bienes o recursos de otra persona, no de los nuestros.

Este mismo concepto se encuentra a lo largo de toda la Sagrada Escritura y la teología católica. Lo vemos por primera vez en los relatos de la creación en el libro del Génesis, donde Dios confía la creación misma al cuidado de la humanidad, para su desarrollo y para el bien de quienes habitan en ella. Jesús también contó parábolas sobre reyes que se marchan de viaje y confían sus bienes a sus siervos, sobre luces que no deben esconderse bajo el celemín, y sobre amos que regresan "como ladrones en la noche", pidiendo cuentas a sus administradores.

San Pablo, en sus epístolas, habla de los múltiples dones del Espíritu Santo concedidos a cada miembro de la Iglesia, con el propósito de proclamar el Evangelio y edificar la Iglesia mediante las obras del ministerio. Se podrían dar aún más ejemplos. Cuando se entiende correctamente, entonces, la corresponsabilidad cristiana no es un lema para la recaudación de fondos. La corresponsabilidad es nuestra respuesta a Dios, quien nos ha confiado la misma misión de Cristo y de la Iglesia, dándonos dones de gracia sin medida para cumplirla, así como recursos materiales y espirituales para sostenerla. La única respuesta adecuada a esta confianza es la humildad y la gratitud. Esta corresponsabilidad no se trata tanto de lo que hacemos en la parroquia o de cuánto damos, sino del por qué lo hacemos.

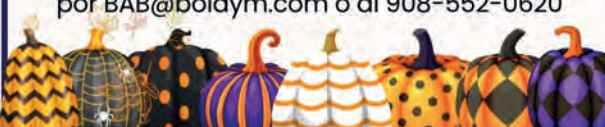
