Diocese of Saint John Protocols for the Public Celebration of Masses in Level 3 of the GNB Covid-19 Winter Plan

In the current Level 3, effective January 14th at 11:59 p.m. until January 30th at 11:59 p.m., churches are restricted to “outdoor, virtual, or in-car religious services only. The dispensation from the Holy Obligation to attend Mass on Sunday is re-instated for the duration of this lockdown phase. Therefore, ALL IN-DOOR, IN-PERSON MASSES are CANCELLED during this time. The only Online Weekend Mass will be celebrated on Sundays at 10 a.m. at St. Vincent de Paul and will be livestreamed via Facebook at <https://www.facebook.com/St-John-Paul-II-Parish-101406744845095/>. Parishioners who want to receive Holy Communion are asked to arrive at the church parking lot 15 minutes before 11 a.m. and to remain in their vehicles while the priest brings Communion to them. Parishioners are encouraged to continue to support our Parish both prayerfully and financially during this time (please see our website stjohnpaul2parishnb.ca for options available for giving).

Father Charles Udeh will be leaving for Nigeria on Thursday, January 20th and arriving back home on Monday, February 28th, 2022.

There will not be any week day Masses or “Adoration to the Blessed Sacrament” while he is away. They will resume as usual on Tuesday, March 1st, 2022. Once In-Door Masses are able to resume, there will be Weekend Masses only on Saturdays and Sundays while he is away. Father Lance Magdziak and Fr. John Jennings will be celebrating the Masses in Fr. Charles’ absence.
