<u>Diocese of Saint John Protocols for the Celebration of Masses - Return to Level 1 of the GNB COVID-19 Winter Plan</u>



On Friday, February 18th, 2022 at 11:59 p.m., the Province moved back to Level 1 of the GNB COVID-19 Winter Plan. In accordance with the information received from the Diocese of Saint John, under Level 1 our parishes will continue to be restricted to physical distancing, operating at 50% capacity, collecting names of attendees by row and all those in attendance are required to wear a mask, except those who have a medical exemption, as per the Public Health Act. One change in the restrictions on Faith gatherings is that congregational singing is now permitted.
