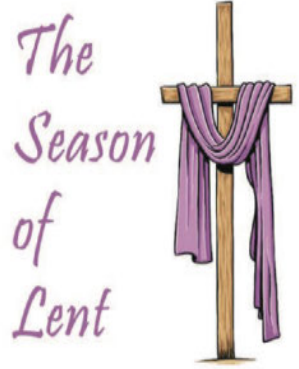

- ♦ Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22, and continues until the beginning of the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 6.



- ♦ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence (*from meat*).
- ♦ All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence (*from meat*) for all who have reached their 14th year.
- ♦ *The Law of Abstinence (from meat)* binds Catholics aged 14 and older.
- ♦ *The Law of Fasting* binds Catholics aged 18 through 59. Fasting allows one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal.

FRIDAY ABSTINENCE AND ST. PATRICK'S DAY ON MARCH 17

In honor of St. Patrick, a secondary patron of the Diocese of Portland, and in recognition that St. Patrick's Day (March 17) falls on a Friday during Lent this year, Bishop Robert Deeley is authorizing individuals who choose to eat meat on that day (i.e., a traditional corned beef and cabbage dinner) to commute (that is, *transfer*) their abstinence from meat to another day within that same week. Parishioners are able to make use of this commutation on St. Patrick's Day for any reason, even if they are not necessarily attending a parish event that day.

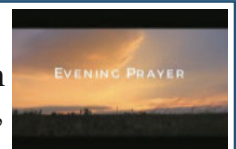

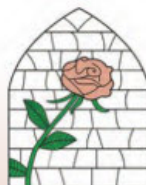
