All the churches in the village work together to supply the East Rochester Community Resource Center food pantry; we at St. Jerome are responsible for keeping the shelves stocked with hygiene items and soups:

- Laundry detergent, disposable razors, shampoo and conditioner, feminine hygiene products, deodorant (men’s and women’s), toothpaste, clorox wipes
- Canned chunky soups, canned cream of chicken soup, canned cream of mushroom soup, canned chicken noodle soup, canned tomato soup, ramen noodle soup

SELECTION PROCESS**

Once again, it is time to discern who in our parish would be willing to serve on the Parish Pastoral Council.

**What is the Pastoral Council?**

- The primary leadership group of the parish.
- Its broad focus is the parish’s life and mission.
- Members are selected rather than elected.

**What makes a good Council Member?**

- Ability to listen; ready to respond to the needs of parishioners.
- Familiar (or a willingness to become familiar) with the parish: what goes on, ministries, facilities, etc.
- Keeps informed on various aspects of parish life.
- Participates in meetings and projects of the Council.

**What type of a commitment is it?**

- 3-year term.
- Regular meetings, usually every other month.
- Involvement in specific Council projects.
