*We encourage each parish to increase the "public" goal you share with your parishioners to promote giving for parish projects as 100% of funds raised above and beyond the parish goal goes back to the parish.

TAO Batches

- Use the Transmittal Form (Appendix 1)—A completed transmittal form must accompany each TAO batch. This form summarizes the total amount of enclosed pledges and payments. Including a calculator tape or an excel sheet listed the pledges and payments is also very helpful.
- **DO NOT Staple Checks to Pledge Cards**—Please avoid stapling checks to pledges cards. Staples left in checks can cause issues during bank processing.
- Keep Pledge Cards with Corresponding Payments (Appendix 2)—Do not separate pledge cards from their payments. Create a pledge card if one is not included with payment.
- **Submit Batches Weekly, If Possible**—Timely submissions help prevent delays in processing. We often have inquiries from parishioners asking why their checks have not cleared. Regular weekly submissions can help minimize these concerns.

TAO Reports

- TAO donor reports are sent out weekly during the initial weeks of the appeal, and then periodically as new gifts are received.
- You may request an updated report at any time.
- Please review and reconcile the report carefully with your parish records. This is an excellent way to catch and correct any discrepancies before pleage reminders are sent to donors.

Tax Acknowledgements

- The Office of Stewardship & Development will send tax acknowledgement letters for <u>ALL</u> TAO contributions as gifts are processed.
- Please **DO NOT** include TAO payments in your parish's annual contribution statements.

Payback & Shortfall Payment Schedule

- The TAO payback schedule for 2025-2026 appeal will be: mid December, mid March, late June.
- Donations received after June 15, 2026 will be applied to 2026-2027 TAO Appeal.
- Any shortfalls to the appeal goal will be billed in late June 2026.

Together As One FAQ's

What is Together as One (TAO)?

Together as One began in the 1970's and is one of three main sources of income for the diocese. Funds raised support a variety of programs throughout the diocese.

How does TAO work?

Each parish is given a goal. Once the goal is met, 100% of the funds raised thereafter are returned to the parish for its individual needs.

Why is it important to support both my parish and TAO?

TAO helps support the ongoing ministries of the Church which provide educational, pastoral, and charitable outreach to those living in the diocese. This support makes possible services that no single parish could provide on its own.

How is the overall TAO goal determined?

The TAO goal is determined by the diocesan budget as the diocese works to provide the services and programs the appeal supports.

How is the TAO parish goal determined?

Each parish has a goal based on each parish's ordinary income.

What happens if my parish does not meet its goal?

If the goal is not met, the balance due is billed to the parish. Last year 29 parishes out of 43 parishes achieved their goal.

How much should I give to TAO?

Charitable giving reflects our Christian stewardship of treasure. Your gift is a personal decision between you and God and should be made after prayerful reflection.

Why are pledges encouraged?

Pledges provide you with the opportunity to make a more significant gift to the mission of the Church over an extended period of time.

How can I make a gift?

Return your pledge card by putting it in the collection basket

Ideas to Improve Participation

- Review the materials provided on the Diocese website: <u>scdiocese.org/taoparishresources</u>.
 Call the Office of Stewardship & Development at 712-233-7524 with questions.
- Parishioners need to have at least two weeks advance notice so they will be prepared to make their pledge. Use bulletin/pulpit announcements and prayers of the faithful in the weeks leading up to kick-off weekend. (Appendix 4)
- Speak and publish only positive things about Together as One and the many programs that provide service to more than 24,000 households. A positive attitude toward the appeal is contagious. (Appendix 5)
- Before the pastor asks the people of the parish to make a pledge, he should make his gift first and explain why he is doing so.
- Utilize weekly pulpit announcements from parish leaders, deacons and/or pastors, sharing your parish's progress towards goal and encouraging participation from all parishioners.
 (Appendix 6)
- Encourage pledging—instead of one-time gifts; remind people they may make a pledge and pay it weekly, biweekly, monthly or quarterly.
- Assure parishioners that every gift is important and every gift helps. Participation is critical to success and shows solidarity with one's faith family. (Appendix 7)
- Keep a few extra pledge cards in all pews and in the back of church readily available and easily accessible to parishioners.
- Ask a lay person to speak for 1-2 minutes about how TAO benefits and impacts them. Ask a
 past or current TAO donor, a recently married couple, your parish bookkeeper or a student
 who has attended a retreat. If you need assistance in identifying a lay speaker, or preparing
 a lay talk, please feel free to contact the Office of Stewardship & Development at 712-2337524. (Appendix 8)
- Ask a few volunteers to call parishioners to personally invite them to participate in the TAO appeal. Call the Office of Stewardship & Development at 712-233-7524 for a sample script.

Did You Know?

Did you know?

- When people feel *inspired* to give to a cause, they tend to give as much as they are able.
- When people feel *obligated* to give, they often give only the minimum expected.
- Our goal is not to have people "give until it hurts", but to invite them to give until it feels good, knowing their gift is making a difference.

What NOT to do:

- Don't apologize for the appeal.
- Don't frame it as a chore or another "required" donation. This is an
 <u>opportunity</u> for Stewardship or time, talent and treasure.
- Avoid discouraging statements such as
 - "I know our economy has not been very strong the last few years, and many of you are struggling, so just give if you can Or any similar opinion-based comments.

Let parishioners prayerfully decide their level of commitment. Their decision is a personal matter between them and God.

Combine a Parish Campaign with TAO Fundraising

Parishes wishing to raise additional funds over its Together as One (TAO) parish goal can do so by linking a parish project(s) with TAO fundraising. The additional funds raised can accomplish a specific capital project, add to a savings/endowment, help with repairs or pay a debt.

100% of everything raised over the TAO parish goal is returned to the parish.

Advantages:

- The parish can accomplish a special project(s) without having a separate fundraiser.
- Once the TAO parish goal is achieved, the excess is refunded back to the parish as non-ordinary income.
- The Diocese manages the pledge redemption so that you do not have to do additional mailings or accounting.
- You can ask parishioners for a gift that is equal to the TAO parish goal plus the parish project(s) amount divided by the number of envelope holders.
- Because of a parish project(s), more people are willing to participate because it is something concrete that benefits the parish while accomplishing the annual appeal responsibility.

Some things to consider:

- The TAO parish goal has to be met first, before funds become available for any parish project(s).
- Parish leaders need to develop a flyer describing the parish project(s).
- The parish project(s) marketing materials need to be made available at the same time as the TAO Annual Appeal announcement.

Suggestions:

- Do a parish mailing follow-up of non-respondents after a few weeks.
- Suggest that gifts are paid in installments whether that means biweekly, monthly or quarterly.
- State that whatever amount anyone can give is appreciated. Full parish participation is important.
- Be open to a parish campaign for a couple years if the parish campaign total is not achieved in the first year.

Here's how you can say Thank You!

- **Children's Liturgy Participants:** Invite the children to color or write a thank you message to your generous donors. Their heartfelt creativity is a wonderful way to show appreciation.
- Together As One Event Attendees: Do you have parishioners who have participated in TAO-sponsored events, such as the Men's Conference, Women's Gathering or Marriage Preparation? Encourage them to volunteer by writing a personal thank you note, sharing how the event deepened their faith and helped bring them Together As One.
- **Confirmation Students:** Are your Confirmation students looking to earn volunteer hours? Invite them to contribute by sharing how attending religious education classes or a Catholic school has shaped their faith journey. Their reflections can make meaningful thank you messages.
- Letter: A heartfelt thank you letter from the pastor or finance council will let the parishioner know their gift was appreciated. (Appendix 9)

LAY LEADER SAMPLE TALK:

Hi, my name is Jane Doe, and I have been a parishioner here at ______ for 10 years. I grew up Catholic, attended Catholic schools, and have always appreciated what my faith has brought to me in my life through my wonderful family growing up, the husband and children I have now, and the friends I have made in my Catholic community here and throughout the Diocese.

Two years ago, I attended the Women's Conference for the first time. It was truly a life-changing experience on many levels, and it made me grow closer to God, but also to my parish life. I realized that I needed to "step it up," if I wanted more out of my faith. And, it worked. I began attending a weekly bible study and offering to read at mass on Sundays. I volunteered my time with various activities at church and through non-profits in our area like the Soup Kitchen, which I had never done before, and spent hours each week at adoration. Finally, I introduced myself to people at our parish that I hadn't met before, and found new friends in this community that I may not have found before, and our Catholic faith brought us together.

This year's theme for Our Diocesan Annual Appeal: Together as One has resonated with me more than any other appeal. We are all in this together, through good times and hard times, and this year has offered us some very hard times we were not anticipating. I thank God every day for my faith that keeps me strong in difficulty. We need to make our parish and Catholic church strong, not only for us now, but for our children as they grow up and have many choices that face them in their lives. I pray daily that our parish sends the strong message, that we are Together as One to my children so that they never decide that they want to leave their faith behind. I think we can all agree on that.

Today I come to you as your sister, your friend, your faith community member and prayerfully ask you to give to this year's appeal. We need a strong parish, and a strong Diocese. We need to come Together as One and share the gifts we have with the parish we love. If you haven't given in past years out of annoyance or bitterness, I ask you to put that aside this year and offer a gift of treasure. If you give every year, I ask you to consider increasing your gift this year.

Finally, I ask you to consider this question: What AM I doing to improve my faith life? What AM I doing to give back to this parish? What more can I do to help with time, talent or treasure? Do I pray more often for things I want than offering thanks for all that I have? How have I thanked my parish for continued ministry, even through the pandemic? And one more, Do I regularly thank God for all he has given me in my life with the treasures I have?
