Today We Begin Our Advent Journey to Christmas

Today, our Advent journey to Christmas begins. The word Advent actually means "the coming." It is from the Latin "adventus," meaning "anticipation." Are you wondering how to make your own journey to Bethlehem more spiritual as you prepare and anticipate the birth of Jesus? I would invite you to attend Mass during the week as the readings are very powerful preparing for the Nativity of Our Lord. I would also invite you and/or your family to pray the Rosary (the Joyful Mysteries are great for Advent). Possibly pray the daily Scripture readings




