Lenten Season Updates

We are now a little over a week into the Lenten season and I hope you are off to a great start with your spiritual practices of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. The Parish office has been closed for Spring Break and most of our students are traveling, so it's been quiet around here.

Our Search Committee for a Director of Campus Ministry has been hard at work reviewing resumes of applicants. We have designated April 15 as the last day to apply. So far we have been blessed with some outstanding applicants.

Earlier, in one of Fr. Jeffrey's FAQ's he mentioned that we have had overwhelming support for an external audit of the parish finances. This coming week we will meet with representatives of Watkins, Ward, and Stafford, PLLC. CPA firm in order to engage their services for a review of our finances and internal controls.

UPDATES CONT

As most of you know, I have moved the rectory at St. Joseph to the house on Herbert Street behind the church parking lot. At the moment, no one is living at the house the parish owns at The Lakes. I wanted to move here initially to be present to the parish. When I moved in, it was pointed out that the roof needed some immediate attention. There has even been a small leak spotted in the house. The Finance Council, Fr. Jeffrey, and I have received four estimates and are reviewing those to make a decision about replacing the roof. The bids range from \$4,945.00 to \$6,200.00. In the coming weeks and months we will also be discussing the future of the house at The Lakes.

In the next week we will have a Pastoral Council meeting and a Finance Council meeting where we will discuss some very important topics. Please pray for us so that we might help make the decisions that we need to help continue our mission and bring about our vision.

Also, as noted last week, on Tuesday the Diocese of Jackson will release a list of names of clergy who have been credibly accused of sexual abuse of a minor. Please continue to pray for all of those involved, especially any victim of such abuse.

Remember to stay focused on the Lord and keep your eyes fixed on Him and His mercy. Let's also go to St. Joseph and ask for his intercession as patron of the universal church, patron of fathers, and terror of demons...St. Joseph...Pray for us!

Anyone who has been a victim of abuse or exploitation by clergy, religious or lay church personnel and has not yet reported it is encouraged to do so. The Victim Assistance Coordinator, Valerie McClellan, a licensed social worker, is available to assist in making a report.
