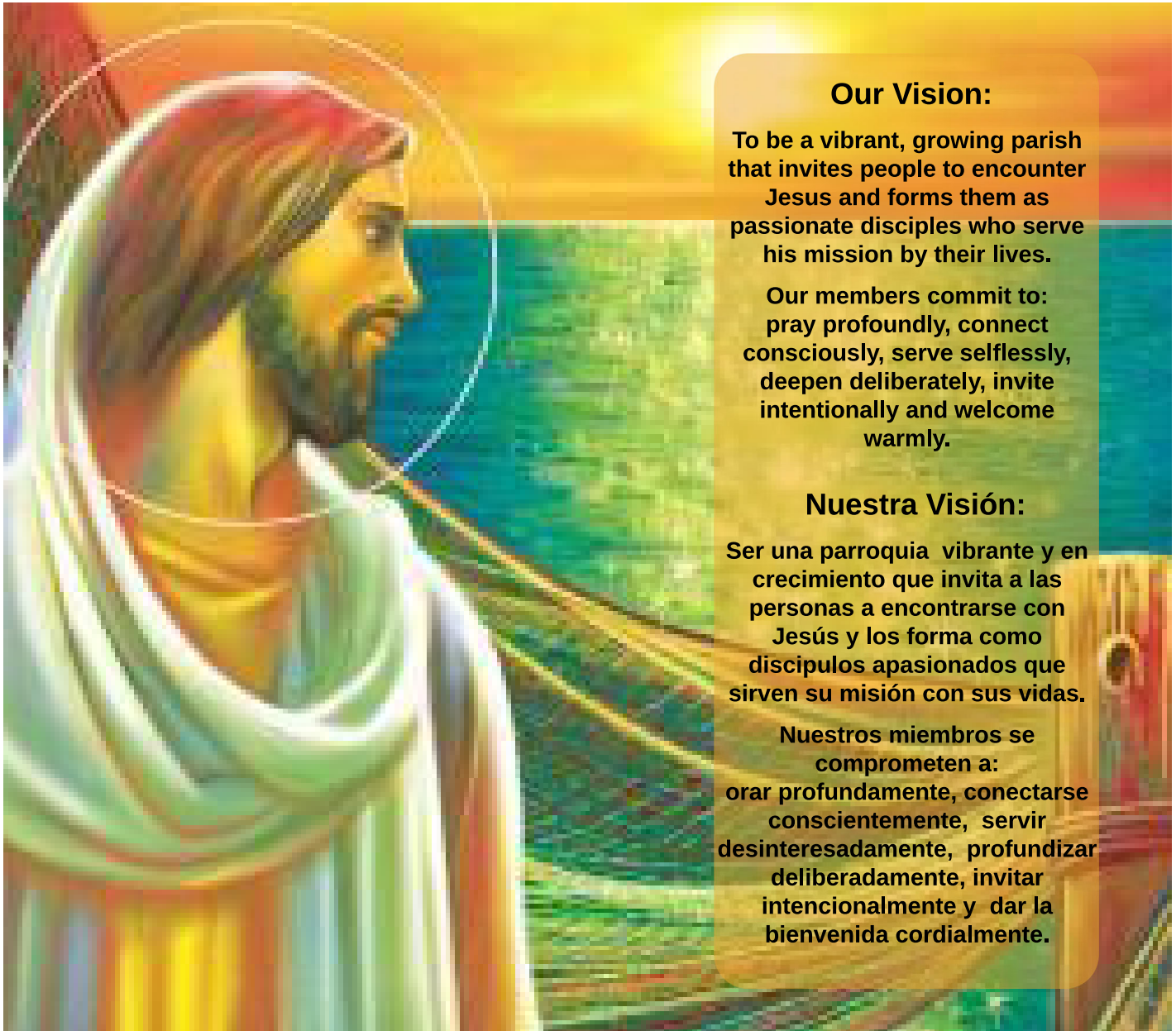

Source & Summit: Liturgical Questions & Answers

Find "Your Way"

Last year I turned 40, and with that came the inevitable ponderings of the track of life and taking stock of things. That became a real desire to sort through life's priorities. Doing so has led to real changes for the better, little by little. My motto last year I stole from St. Francis de Sales about being gentle with oneself, and I think I'm going to work on that even more in 2020!

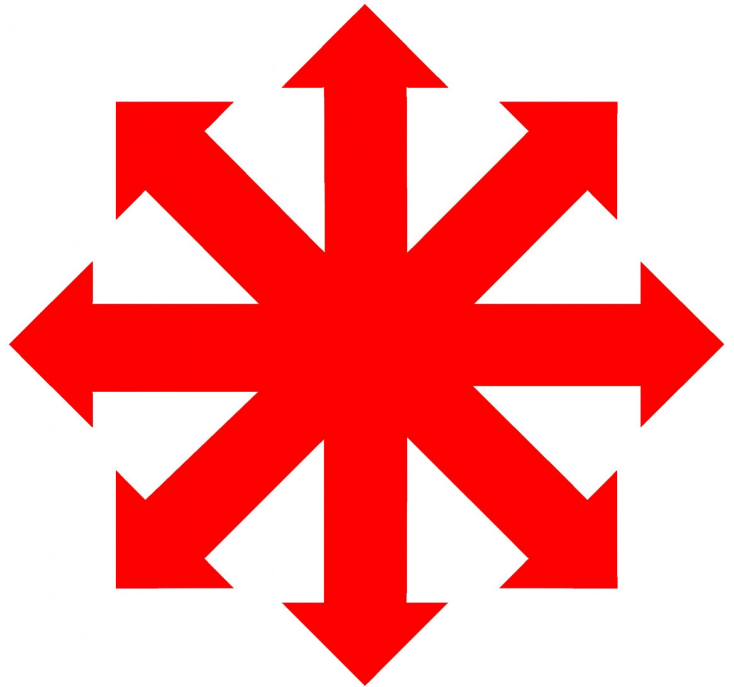
We all have these threshold moments in our lives that trigger some introspection and asking the question, "Now what?" Like graduating high school or college, getting laid off from a job, having your first child, children going off to school, retirement. Where do we look for answers for taking that next step? Trusted mentors, elders, pastors, coaches, teachers, best friends, siblings, prayer, scripture and maybe that voice within as well.

Before Christians were called Christians, they were called simply "The Way". This was because they lived their lives differently and it was obvious to those who encountered them. Their following of Christ was evident in all aspects of their lives. This might lead us to believe that all Christians think, look and act the same, however, we are all created uniquely, not one of us is exactly alike even at our birth, let alone after our life experiences. Yet God knows each of us down to the very smallest details. Psalm 139 says, "You formed my inmost being; you knit me in my mother's womb... My very self you know." So, though each of us is called to be a follower of Christ, "The Way" for each of us is going to be different. We all may be seeking the same thing, but how we get there is our own unique journey.

Sometimes I think we settle to conform to what we see around us. We learn by imitating, which is fine, but imitation without some reflection is limiting. Worse, we often compare our spiritual lives to others and wish we seemed more holy like Sally or had deeper spiritual experiences like Bob. But, reality is, we are called to much, much more. The God of the entire universe is also the Jesus of the interior of our hearts. Your life journey is both "The Way" but also "Your Way" and it is not going to look like someone else's way, and should definitely not be compared. This is one thing in life that is definitely not a competition!

So as we continue to journey into 2020, especially when these "Now what?" moments come up, let's remember that our journey is our own, that God knows and speaks to us personally in many different ways, and it's our job to try to discern where and how we are being led. Let's try not to be too anxious about what that might look like, in comparison with others. And, for one another, let's be respectful rather than judgemental of "Their Way", that their path and timing are their own.

Imagine what the world would be like if every person were supported and encouraged to live their life as God truly made and called them. In our own small circles of influence, starting with ourselves, let's commit to do the best we can.

Preguntas y Respuestas Litúrgicas

LAS OBRAS DE MISERICORDIA:

Corporales y Espirituales.

"Y Jesús, teniendo misericordia de él... " (Mc 40-41).

Misericordia es una palabra muy bella y se forma como resultado de la unión de otras dos: Miser= miseria y Cordia= corazón.

Misericordia es, entonces, sentir en lo profundo de nuestro corazón la miseria del otro, más exactamente sentir "con" el otro el mismo dolor y, por eso mismo, darle el auxilio que esté en nuestras manos. La misericordia nace en el corazón y llama a la acción.

Las obras de misericordia están en la Biblia. Son amorosas formas de estar atentos a la presencia de Jesús en el necesitado, hoy más que nunca ser samaritano. Estar atento.

Jesús nos invita a una fe activa que obre a través del amor. Las obras de misericordia son las acciones de amor fraterno a las que nos invita Nuestro Señor. Se trata de ser caritativos, de contemplar, de entender y de ayudar al otro en sus necesidades corporales y espirituales (Hb 13,3).

Hay un hermoso pasaje del Evangelio que resume muy bien lo que Jesús valora de las acciones de los hombres: "Tuve hambre y me dieron de comer; tuve sed y me dieron de beber; fui extranjero y me recibieron en su casa; estaba desnudo y me vistieron; enfermo y me visitaron; en la cárcel y fueron a verme" (Mt 25, 35-36).



Dios nos pide que nos amemos los unos a otros con un amor generoso y humilde. Hacer el ejercicio de vivir ese amor a través de estas Obras de Misericordia tal vez no sea del todo sencillo, pero es seguro que este camino nos hace más parecidos a Jesús. No dejemos nunca de intentar vivir el amor fraterno que nos hace hermanos en Cristo.

Estamos llamados a mirar la obra de Jesús en nuestro corazón, sentir ese profundo amor fraterno y salir a buscar a quien nos necesita.

Ahora que sabemos cómo obrar con misericordia, existen catorce obras de misericordia: siete corporales y siete espirituales:

Obras de Misericordia Corporales.

1. Dar de comer al hambriento
2. Dar de beber al sediento
3. Dar posada al necesitado
4. Vestir al desnudo
5. Visitar al enfermo
6. Socorrer a los presos
7. Enterrar a los muertos

Obras de Misericordia Espirituales:

1. Enseñar al que no sabe
2. Dar buen consejo al que lo necesita
3. Corregir al que está en error
4. Perdonar las injurias
5. Consolar al triste o dolorido
6. Sufrir con paciencia los defectos de los demás
7. Rogar a Dios por vivos y difuntos

Finalizo con unas palabras del Papa Francisco sobre la misericordia:

"Queridos hermanos y hermanas, dejémonos envolver por la misericordia de Dios; confiemos en su paciencia que siempre nos concede tiempo; tengamos el valor de volver a su casa, de habitar en las heridas de su amor dejando que Él nos ame, de encontrar su misericordia en los sacramentos"
(Papa Francisco).

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD- When February 2 falls on a Sunday, the solemnity of the day, the Presentation of the Lord, is celebrated instead of the ordinary time Sunday. The Presentation of the Lord recalls that, forty days after Jesus was born, Mary and Joseph bring him to the temple to be presented. It is there they encounter an elderly couple, Simeon and Anna, who immediately recognize the infant Jesus as the Savior of the World. This day has also traditionally been the day when candles are blessed. The light of the candle, whether it be in the temple of our church, our home, or our hearts, is meant to help us understand Jesus as the one who illuminates each of our paths. At each of the Masses next weekend, everyone will receive a candle, and we will begin Mass with a special ritual to bless these candles. Please take your candle home with you after Mass and use it in your prayer as a reminder that Jesus is with us not just here at church, but in our day-to-day lives.



THE FIRST SATURDAY HOLY HOUR will be held this Saturday, February 1 starting at 9:30 am after the 9:00 am Mass. This devotion consists of a rosary and other prayers plus time for private adoration and prayers, all during the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT will be held Thursday, February 6, 7:30 am - 8:45 pm in the Chapel. Everyone is invited and encouraged to come at any time, for any length of time.

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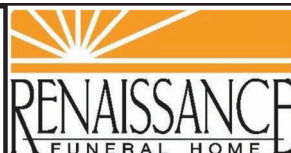
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
