GOSPEL REFLECTION: A WOMAN SPREADS THE GOOD NEWS

The woman at the well encounters Jesus and then preaches the Good News to all she knows. We really don't know much about the woman. Jesus says she has had five husbands. Is she divorced? Widowed? We do know she is a Samaritan, a member of a different religious tradition. For a Jewish man to speak to her was shocking.

Jesus' knowledge of her personal life convinces her that he is a great prophet. When he reveals himself as the Messiah, she believes. Then she goes and tells everyone she knows. They believe her because of her personal testimony.

This woman is a great model of one important role of women in the Church, evangelizing and preaching the Good News to their friends and family.

From the Parochial Vicar

Dear Parishioners and Extended Family Members,

Praised be Jesus Christ! Since this is such a significant week for those of Irish decent, I offer you the following:

St. Patrick - A Reflection by Fr. Martin Coffey C.P., a Passionist priest

St. Patrick is known and admired all over the world as the young slave who became an unlikely hero, the shy boy transformed into a courageous missionary. Patrick came to an alien land that soon became his adopted home, and a foreign people became his friends. He was no brilliant scholar but a man of deep faith, tried and tested in the fires of slavery and exile. At first a reluctant preacher until filled with the strength of the Trinity, he overcame his fears and limitations to establish one of the strongest Churches in the Christian world.

Man of God

Patrick was a towering figure. He had a strong biblical faith centered on the Trinity. He was deeply familiar with the Word of God and pondered it day and night. He lived in intimate union with Christ who was always before, behind, above, within him. Every step he took was in the company of Jesus, every word he spoke was inspired by Jesus, every breath was full of the spirit of Jesus.

Legacy

The legacy he left is most clear in the distinctive Gaelic spirituality that combined Celtic love of nature and monastic closeness to God. The pre-Christian Celts looked for signs of God in the beauty and power of nature. The earliest written Gaelic poem is the *Song of Amergin* which celebrates the presence of God in nature: "I am wind on sea, I am wave in storm, and seven horned stag. I am hawk of cliff, a boar of valor, I am a salmon in a pool."

Echoes of this early Celtic sensitivity to nature are found in Patrick's prayers: I arise today through the strength of heaven: Light of sun, Radiance of moon, Splendor of fire, Speed of lightening, Swiftness of wind, Depth of sea, Stability of earth, Firmness of rock.

Monastic

From the very beginning the Irish found the simple beauty of the monastic life very attractive and in a few short years many monasteries were founded. The monastic life resounds with the sense of God's presence and the constant singing of his praises. The monks learned to pray at all times and to find God in all things. These are the characteristics that shaped the distinctive Christian faith of the Irish.

As we celebrate St. Patrick, whether it be as a parish or with our own plans this week, I hope the above reflection helps us to keep the "reason for the season" in mind. To all of our parishioners of Irish decent, I look forward to celebrating with you a "father of your faith."

DURING LENT, TIPS FOR PREPARING FOR CONFESSION

As Catholics are encouraged to make going to confession a significant part of their lives during Lent, Pope Francis offered some tips to help people prepare for the sacrament of penance. After a brief explanation of why people should go to confession -- "because we are all sinners" -- the pope listed 30 key questions to reflect on as part of making an examination of conscience and being able to "confess well." Confession is meant to be a sincere moment of conversion, an occasion to demonstrate trust in God's willingness to forgive his children and to help them back on the path of following Jesus, Pope Francis wrote.

- Do I only turn to God when I'm in need?
- Do I attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation?
- Do I begin and end the day with prayer?
- Am I embarrassed to show that I am a Christian?
- Do I rebel against God's plan?
- Am I envious, hot-tempered, biased?
- Am I honest and fair with everyone or do I fuel the "throwaway culture?"
- In my marital and family relations, do I uphold morality as taught in the Gospels?
- Do I honor and respect my parents?
- Have I refused newly conceived life? Have I snuffed out the gift of life? Have I helped do so?
- Do I respect the environment?
- Am I part worldly and part believer?
- Do I overdo it with eating, drinking, smoking and amusements?
- Am I overly concerned about my physical well-being, my possessions?
- How do I use my time? Am I lazy?
- Do I want to be served?
- Do I dream of revenge, hold grudges?
- Am I meek, humble and a builder of peace?

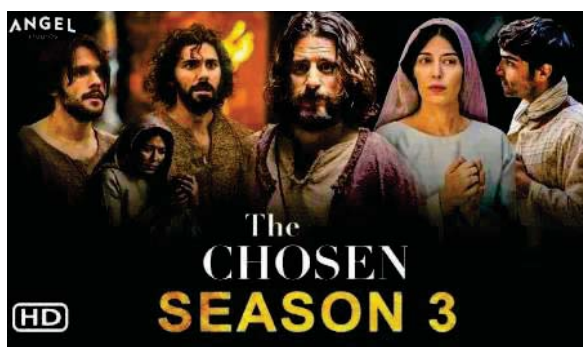

*May they and their families be guided by the Spirit,
as they prepare to receive and celebrate these beautiful gifts.*

The two elements which are especially characteristic of Lent – the recalling of baptism or the preparation for it, and penance – should be given greater emphasis in the liturgy and in liturgical catechesis. It is by means of them that the Church prepares the faithful for the celebration of Easter, while they hear God's word more frequently and devote more time to prayer.

Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (No 109)

MASS INTENTIONS

One way we pray for people in need, both the living and dead (canon 945 §1), is through having a Mass said for that intention. Pope Paul VI said, "The Mass is the most perfect form of prayer," and is said in communion with the entire Universal Church. Mass intentions are a great treasure of the Church and have a spiritual weight that is incalculable. An offering is given freely, by the faithful, primarily out of their concern for the Church and their desire to support its material needs. The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church, and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works (Can. 946).



REQUESTING A MASS INTENTION - Due to the high requests for Intentions at certain Masses - as a rule, there is only one Mass intention per Mass. Multiple names from the same person are acceptable and are considered one Intention. If the requested Mass is not available, we will advise you of other available dates.

“ HER TREATMENTS GOT ME BACK ON THE GOLF COURSE

Local clinic uses modern medical solutions to treat chronic pain and get patients back to doing the things they love with the people they love.

“I hurt my back playing golf. I went to the chiropractor. I went to the pain institute. I went to the spine institute. Nothing helped. The pain was debilitating, I went six or seven months without playing.” ~ Rod O. (Peabody)

Chronic pain makes everyday life incredibly difficult. It prevents you from participating in activities you once loved, even simple daily tasks like grocery shopping become nearly impossible.

This was the case for Rod O. of Peabody, MA.

Rod would go on to explain that on a scale of one to ten his pain was well over a nine, every single day. 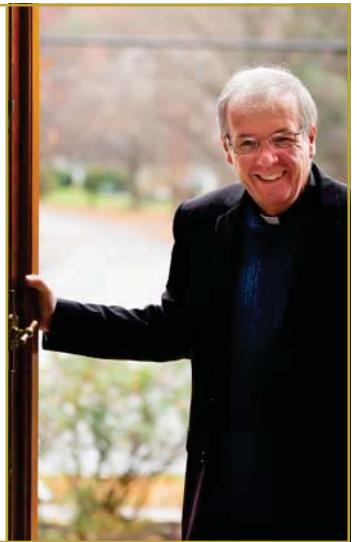
