## From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

During the month of May, the Church invites us to turn our hearts and minds in a special way to the Blessed Virgin Mary. For centuries, the faithful have honored Mary throughout this month with more fervent and loving acts of homage and veneration in both our churches and our homes. May offers a beautiful opportunity to reflect on Mary's unique role in salvation history and to seek her powerful intercession for our needs.

I encourage you to pray the Rosary during this Marian month, along with the *Regina Caeli*, the traditional Marian antiphon recited and sung during the Easter season:

Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia. Has risen as He said, alleluia. Pray for us to God, alleluia.

V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.

R. For the Lord is truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray:

O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant, we beseech You, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may come to share the joys of everlasting life.

Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

One of the cherished traditions of May is the May Crowning. The earliest records of this practice go back to the 8th century. Over time, it has developed into the beautiful custom of crowning a statue or image of Mary with flowers—symbolizing her queenship and our devotion to her as our spiritual Mother. This gesture serves as a visible reminder of Mary's exalted place in Heaven as Queen of Heaven and Earth. I invite you to join us this weekend for our May Crowning at the 8:30 AM and 10:00 AM Masses.

Over the past two weekends, we've had the joy of celebrating 80 First Holy Communions—a sign of life and growth in our parish. Congratulations to our First Communicants and their families! I also want to extend heartfelt thanks to Paula Colpitts, our Director of Evangelization, whose dedication and love for the faith continue to bless our children as they prepare for the sacraments. A special thanks as well to Jackie Steele and Janet Davidson-Dee for their work, and to our devoted catechists for their efforts in helping our young people grow closer to Christ.






