

From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

Over the last several months our Pastoral Planning Committee has been working hard to evaluate the overall state of our parish, in terms of our financial stability and our vitality. Part of this effort has led to the discernment of a new parish mission statement, which I will be preaching about at all of the Masses this weekend. After prayer and discernment, this is what we have come up with:

"Rooted in truth, prayer, and the sacraments, our parish is a spiritual home where we follow Christ, build community, and share the Gospel — bringing hope and healing to all."

While I will be preaching about our new mission statement, I'll break it down briefly in this letter.

Rooted in truth, prayer, and the sacraments

Everything we are as a parish begins with Jesus Christ. The teachings of His Church keep us grounded in the truth about God, the truth about who we are as human beings, and the truth about God's plan for our salvation. Prayer keeps us connected in friendship with Jesus, and the sacraments pour out His Divine Life into our souls. This is our foundation—without it, we lose our identity.

Our parish is a spiritual home

When we call the parish our *spiritual home*, it means more than simply a place we attend on Sundays. A home is where we belong, where we are known, and where we contribute. Just as we take care of our own homes, we are called to take ownership of our parish—through our prayers, participation, service, and generosity. This is the place that forms us, strengthens us, and spurs us on in our journey to heaven.

Where we follow Christ

To be a follower of Jesus Christ means to be His disciple. Discipleship is at the heart of who we are. To be Catholic is to walk daily with Jesus—learning from Him, trusting Him, and imitating Him in word and deed.

Build community

Our parish is called to be a place of unity and fellowship, where all are welcomed and cared for, and where each person's gifts are shared for the good of the whole Body of Christ.

And share the Gospel

The mission of the Church is not only inward but outward. We are sent out to witness to Christ in our families, workplaces, schools, and neighborhoods. Evangelization is not optional—it is the natural fruit of being rooted in Christ. Jesus Himself tells us in the Great Commission, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19-20). This mission is for each and every Catholic.

Bringing hope and healing to all

We all know that our world is in desperate need of God's mercy, peace, and joy. By our words and actions, and especially through the grace of the sacraments, we bring Christ's healing presence into a broken world.

As we move forward as a parish community, I invite you to pray with this mission statement and to ask the Lord how He is calling you personally to live it out.

This week, you will be receiving in the mail a letter from the Pastoral Planning Committee updating you on the work they've been doing. I ask that you please read through it and continue to keep the members of the PPC in your prayers.

A Note 🎵 from the Music Director

Why do we sing at Mass?

This is a commonly asked question. To start though, we don't sing <u>at</u> Mass, we sing <u>the</u> Mass. Just about the entire Mass could actually be sung, between the priest and the people. The Second Vatican council's constitution on the Sacred Liturgy says this: "The purpose of sacred music...is the glory of God and the sanctification of the faithful." We are giving glory and praise to God through the singing of the Mass. Some of the words we sing are taken directly from the Bible: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will" (Gloria, and Luke 2:14); "Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts, heaven and earth are full of your glory!" (Sanctus, Isaiah 6:3, Revelation 4:8). As Fr. Bobby said in his bulletin letter last week, "we come to Mass to worship, to pray, and to offer ourselves fully to the Lord." And as Deacon Matt said in his homily, we are not here to watch the Mass, but to live the Mass. Praying and singing the words of Scripture teaches us to pray; the parts of the Mass are a kind of extended meditation on the Word of God which leads us to contemplation.

Are you a young family looking for your faith community? Are you pregnant and want to meet other new parents? Are you a new couple without kids looking to meet other young married couples?


