

From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

In the Letter to the Hebrews this week we hear these beautiful words:

"You have approached Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all, and the spirits of the just made perfect, and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and the sprinkled blood that speaks more eloquently than that of Abel." (Hebrews 12:22–24)

Every time we gather for Mass, we are not simply attending an earthly event—we are being drawn into the heavenly liturgy. At every Mass, heaven and earth meet, the angels and saints surround us, and Jesus Christ Himself becomes present in our midst.

Because of this great mystery, the Church always seeks to celebrate the liturgy with beauty, reverence, and transcendence. Bishop Robert Barron often reminds us that worship should lift our hearts beyond the ordinary. When we step into the church, it should feel different—like stepping away from the world and into God's presence. A sense of the sacred should envelop us as we prepare to celebrate Mass.

With this in mind, I'd like to share with you a change that many of you have already noticed. Over the past month, we have been celebrating Mass without the projectors and screens. After prayer and discernment, this will now become a permanent change. I want to acknowledge that the screens served an important purpose during COVID, when we were cautious about germs. I am also very grateful to those who generously donated funds for the projectors and screens. Please know that these gifts will still be put to good use: at St. Agnes, the projectors will replace the older ones in our second-floor parish center that are in need of updating. At St. Athanasius, the screens will remain in place for now, and we will work to repurpose them as well.

We all know how much screens dominate our daily lives. Studies show the average American spends more than seven hours a day in front of them. When we come to Mass, it's healthy for our souls to have a break from that constant pull. Instead of looking at a screen, our eyes should be lifted to the altar, to the crucifix, to the beauty of the church, and to the sacred mysteries taking place before us.

Of course, active participation in the liturgy—as encouraged by the Second Vatican Council—is essential. But this participation is not only external, like singing, responding, or following words in a text. As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, true participation is also profoundly internal. Lifting our hearts and minds to God in prayer, contemplation, and reverence, we offer all that He has graciously given to us back to Him in worship. Beauty, silence, and sacred music all serve this deeper participation, drawing us more fully into the Paschal Mystery: the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I realize this change will continue to take some getting used to, but I am already encouraged by how many of you are turning to the missalettes. Please continue to make use of them. Read and meditate upon the Scriptures before Mass begins, pray some of the beautiful devotional prayers in the back, and follow along with the hymns so that you can sing with full voice. Please also know that we are currently working on a worship supplement for the 8:30am Mass, which will continue to have more contemporary music.

Friends, the Mass is a foretaste of heaven. Let us treasure it as a sacred time set apart from the world, a time when God draws near and we worship Him with all of the angels and the saints.






Confirmation Preparation Program: Volunteers & Enrollment




