From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings from France!

As I write this, we are about halfway through our pilgrimage, and I find myself in the city of Nevers, where St. Bernadette spent the final years of her life as a Sister of Charity. Here, her incorrupt body rests, a moving reminder of her holiness and of the simplicity with which she lived her vocation after the extraordinary events at Lourdes.

We began our pilgrimage in Lourdes, walking in the very footsteps of young Bernadette. It was deeply moving to celebrate Mass at the grotto where Our Blessed Mother appeared to her 18 times. We lit candles for our intentions, joined in the candlelight rosary procession with pilgrims from around the world, and blessed ourselves in the miraculous spring that has brought healing to so many.



From Lourdes, we traveled to Toulouse to venerate the relics of the Angelic Doctor, St. Thomas Aquinas, whose wisdom continues to guide the Church. Then we made our way to Paray-le-Monial, a place filled with the love of Christ, where Jesus revealed His Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. We celebrated Mass in the Apparitions Chapel, giving thanks for the boundless mercy and love poured out upon us through the Heart of Jesus.

At each holy site, I have carried all of you in prayer. Please know that you have been remembered at the altar and entrusted to the saints we have encountered along the way.

While pilgrimages are always a blessing, I miss all of you and look forward to being back with you next weekend. As you may have seen in our parish announcements, October will be a special month for us as we take a deeper look together at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Each weekend will focus on a particular part of the liturgy, and Fr. Steve and I will alternate preaching at every Mass. My bulletin letters throughout October will also reflect each week's theme. In addition, our Faith and Fellowship groups will be reading Dr. Edward Sri's excellent book *A Biblical Walk Through the Mass*. If you are not yet part of a group, this is a perfect time to join!

And don't forget to mark your calendars for our Second Annual Parish Oktoberfest on Sunday, October 26, following the 11:30 AM Mass. It will be another wonderful opportunity for food, fellowship, and fun as a parish family.

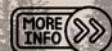

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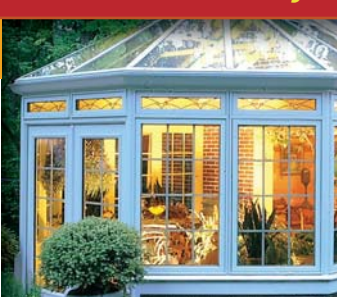
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
