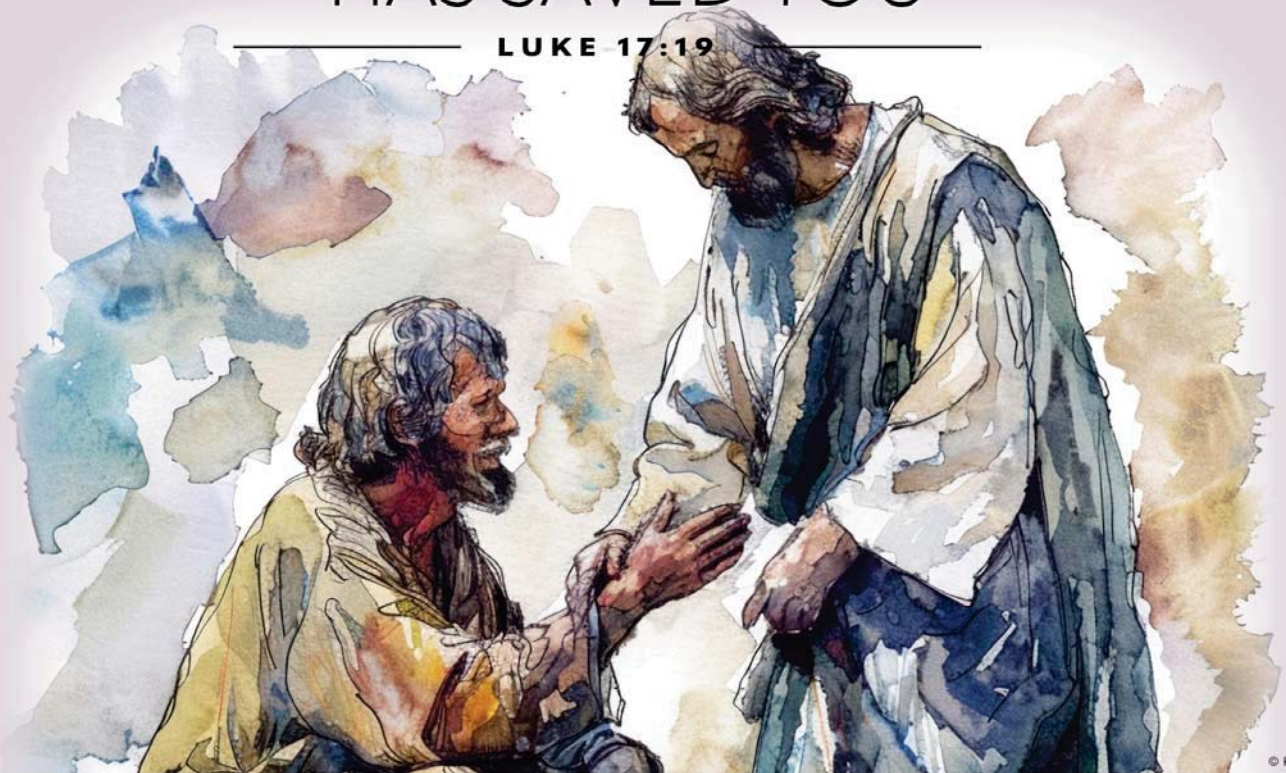

**From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc**

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last weekend we began our four-part series: *Made for Worship: Understanding the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass*. We reflected on why we go to Mass on Sunday—because God deserves our worship. We were reminded that the Mass is not something we simply “get something out of” but an act of justice and love toward the One who has given us everything. God has given us life, sustains us, and redeemed us on the Cross. The Catechism teaches that “justice means giving to someone what is rightfully theirs,” and that we owe God everything—our worship, our thanksgiving, our praise. Because He is the source of our very existence, offering Him worship is the proper repayment of His infinite generosity.

This week, we turn to look more closely at how the Mass begins in the **Introductory Rites**, followed by the **Liturgy of the Word**. These are not just formalities before “the real action” of the Eucharist begins; they are important parts of our encounter with Christ. Every movement and prayer in the Mass draws us deeper into the mystery of worship.

When we gather together on Sundays, we come from our separate lives—different homes, schedules, and worries, but we assemble as one Body of Christ, the Church herself, called together by the Lord. As the priest and ministers process in, we stand to greet Christ, represented in the priest who acts *in persona Christi*, in the Word that will be proclaimed, and in the Eucharist that will be consecrated. The opening hymn lifts our hearts and unites our voices in praise.

Then comes a moment of humility—the **Penitential Act**. Before we dare to approach the holy mysteries, we acknowledge our sins and our need for mercy. It is as if we are saying, “Lord, cleanse my heart so I may worship You worthily.” This is followed by the **Gloria**, a song of joy that bursts forth as we glorify God for His mercy and love—echoing the hymn of the angels at Bethlehem: “Glory to God in the highest!”

After the **Collect** (opening prayer), we enter into the **Liturgy of the Word**, where God Himself speaks to His people. The same Lord who once spoke to Moses on the mountain and to the prophets of Israel now speaks directly to us through His Living Word. The readings from the Old Testament, the Psalms, the Epistles, and the Gospel all unfold the story of salvation and remind us who we are in God’s plan. As the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us, “The word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart” (Heb 4:12). When the Scriptures are proclaimed, it is Christ Himself who speaks to us, inviting us to listen with open hearts.

The **homily** then helps us bridge the Word of God to our daily lives, guiding us to see how His truth applies to our hearts today. The **Creed** follows, as we stand and publicly profess the faith that unites us as Catholics throughout the world and across the centuries. Finally, in the **Prayer of the Faithful**, we lift up the needs of the Church and the world, joining our prayers to those of Christ, our great High Priest.

By the time we reach the end of the Liturgy of the Word, our hearts have been prepared—purified by repentance, instructed by the Word, and strengthened by faith. We are now ready to approach the altar for the great mystery of the Eucharist.

The first half of the Mass teaches us that worship begins with listening. Before we offer anything to God, we first allow Him to speak. As the Lord told the prophet Isaiah, “Pay attention and come to me; listen, that you may have life” (Isaiah 55:3). In the Introductory Rites and the Liturgy of the Word, we are reminded that every act of true worship begins in the heart that listens and responds.

Next week, we will turn to the heart of the Mass—the **Liturgy of the Eucharist**, where the sacrifice of Christ is made present on the altar. Until then, I encourage you to listen more attentively at Mass this Sunday—to the prayers, the readings, and the silent moments—because through them, God Himself is speaking to you.

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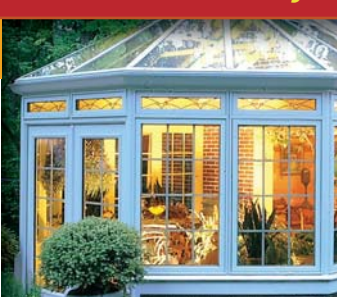
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
