Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend we begin the beautiful and solemn season of Advent, my favorite liturgical season. I love the excitement and anticipation of this annual journey of preparation for the coming of our Savior. Advent invites us to watch, to wait, and to make room in our hearts for the Lord who comes to us in three ways: in history at Bethlehem, in mystery in the sacraments, and in majesty at the end of time. It is a season of hope as the light of Christ enters into our darkened world. The Church, in her wisdom, gives us prayers, liturgies, and traditions to help us open our hearts more fully to Christ's presence.

Everything we are offering in our parish this Advent is meant to help you prepare your soul, quiet your mind, and awaken deeper longing for Jesus. I warmly invite you and your families to take part in as many of these opportunities as possible. Each one offers a unique way to encounter the Lord and to enter more deeply into the spirit of this holy season:

Rorate Masses

December 6th at 6:30am at St. Agnes and December 13th at 6:30am at St. Athanasius

Last year, so many of you sacrificed sleep (and I think you're glad that you did) to celebrate Mass at dawn. These early morning Masses, celebrated by candlelight in honor of Our Blessed Lady, immerse us in the quiet longing of Advent. Spiritually, we walk through Advent with Mary, as we prepare to welcome our Savior.

Blessing of the Crèche

December 6th at 5:00pm after the 4:00pm Mass at St. Athanasius

Bring your family to the outdoor blessing of our parish Nativity scene. Afterward, stay for carols around the creche, followed by hot chocolate, cookies and fellowship in the PAC.


Blessing of the Nativity Saturday, December 6 St. Athanasius at 5:00 PM


