From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

My Dear Friends in Christ,

The Savior is nigh. He draws close to us. As Christmas approaches, allow yourself to enter deeply into these most joyful mysteries of our faith. Come to the stable; enter in, be welcomed by Mary and Joseph, and ponder what you will offer the Christ Child this year. Remember that He came to give Himself entirely for you. What, then, will you offer Him in return?

I warmly invite you, your family, and your friends to celebrate the Birth of Jesus with us this Christmas. Our schedule is a bit different this year, as we will not have a Fieldhouse Mass, but this gives us a beautiful opportunity to gather and worship in our parish churches. In recent months, I have been grateful to see so many new faces at Mass—signs that hearts are returning to God and to His Church. Let us be intentional about inviting those who have been away and warmly welcoming those who are new to our community.

I would especially like to extend an invitation to our Midnight Mass, particularly if you have never been before. The Midnight Mass is one of my favorite Masses of the entire year. Celebrated under candlelight, it is a moment of profound beauty and sacred stillness as we welcome the birth of Christ in the quiet of the night.

The tradition of Midnight Mass is a very ancient one. As early as the fourth century, Christians in the Holy Land would keep a midnight vigil in Bethlehem, followed by a candlelight procession. In the year 440 AD, Pope St. Sixtus III embraced this custom by celebrating Midnight Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome, where he had erected a small chapel with a manger. Over time, it became customary for the pope to celebrate three Masses on Christmas—at midnight, at dawn, and during the day—a tradition that spread throughout the Church by the eleventh century. We gather at midnight because it is in the darkness that the Light of Christ enters the world. If you are able, I encourage you to experience this beautiful celebration of the Lord's Nativity.

Please know of my prayers for all of you as we make our final preparations for Christmas.

Mary embraces God's will and freely chooses to cooperate with God's grace, thereby fulfilling a crucial role in God's plan of salvation. The Church honors her as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks for her prayers to God on our behalf.



Join Christ the King Parish as we celebrate this special Advent tradition!

One Advent tradition is putting up the Jesse Tree. At St. Athanasius, families decorate the biblical ornaments and place upon the Tree. St. Athanasius' Jesse Tree is located at the back of the church (by the baptismal font) along with the ornaments for families to take. Families may enjoy reading the bible stories behind each. At St. Agnes, the Jesse Tree symbolizes that we are all part of Christ's family. The Tree is located by the baptismal font, and families are invited to take a star of David ornament, decorated with their family name and placed on the Jesse Tree.

Did you know? The Jesse tree helps us connect the custom of decorating Christmas trees to the events leading to Jesus' birth. It is named from Isaiah 11:1: "A shoot shall come out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots." Jesse was the father of King David. We adorn a Jesse tree with illustrated ornaments that represent the people, prophecies, and events leading up to the birth of Jesus. The ornaments of the Jesse tree tell the story of God in the Old Testament, connecting the Advent season with the faithfulness of God across four thousand years of history.

"O" ANTIPHONS

OF ADVENT



The Roman Church has been singing the "O" Antiphons since at least the eighth century. They are the antiphons that accompany the Magnificat canticle of Evening Prayer from **December 17-23**. They are a magnificent theology that uses ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the Old Testament to proclaim the coming Christ as the fulfillment not only of Old Testament hopes, but present ones as well. Their repeated use of the imperative "Come!" embodies the longing of all for the Divine Messiah.
