

From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we celebrate the joyful Solemnity of the Nativity of our Lord, our hearts are drawn once again to the mystery at the center of our Catholic faith: “*The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.*” God enters our world quietly, humbly, and personally—bringing light into darkness, hope into uncertainty, and peace into restless hearts.

This Christmas, I want to share with you some very real signs of hope that I see alive and growing here at Christ the King Parish.

We have begun a new Family Faith Formation program that is not only forming our children, but also bringing families together and helping parents grow more deeply in their own understanding of the faith. Our OCIA program has 18 participants, each courageously responding to God’s call and seeking a deeper relationship with Christ and His Church. We have vibrant young and growing families, an active young adult group, and a brand-new Children’s Choir with 16 joyful voices, lifting their praise to God.

Perhaps most striking of all, I continue to see many new faces at Mass and hear from many people requesting the sacraments—some returning after many years away from the Church. This is not happening only here, but all across the Archdiocese of Boston. I talk with my priest friends, and they see and hear the same things that are happening here in Reading. The Holy Spirit is stirring hearts, and many are coming home.

To those who are new to our parish, and to those who may be with us especially at Christmas: you are truly welcome here. I invite you not only to celebrate with us today but to walk with us every Sunday. Our faith is not meant to be lived in isolation or only on special occasions. It is meant to be lived in community, week by week, as we worship together, grow together, and support one another in faith.

If you sense that something is missing in the world—or perhaps in your own heart— consider that what is missing or what you are longing for is God. Saint Augustine, wrote in His book *Confessions*:

Late have I loved you, O Beauty ever ancient, ever new... You have called, you have cried, and you have pierced my deafness... You have radiated forth, you have shined out brightly, and you have dispelled my blindness. You have sent forth your fragrance, and I have breathed it in, and I long for you. I have tasted you, and I hunger and thirst for you. You have touched me, and I ardently desire your peace.

Saint Augustine was expressing a deep, restless yearning for God after a life of seeking fulfillment in worldly things, culminating in a passionate desire for God’s presence. Here at Christ the King Parish, I think you will find the answer to St. Augustine’s longing – a place where Jesus Christ is present in His Church, where faith is nurtured, and where community is real and growing.

Thank you for being part of this parish family, whether for many years or for the first time. May the peace, joy, and hope of the newborn Christ fill your homes and hearts. On behalf of our parish staff and myself, I wish you and your loved ones a blessed and joyful Christmas season.




