

From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Solemnity of the Epiphany!

Today the Church proclaims that Christ has been revealed to all the nations. Guided by the light of a star, the Magi came from the East, entered a humble home, and adored the newborn King. This annual celebration reminds us that Jesus desires to enter our homes, our families, and every corner of our daily lives.

One beautiful and ancient way the Church helps us live this mystery is through the tradition of *chalking the doors* on this feast. For centuries, priests would visit each home in their parish after the Epiphany to bless the household. As parishes grew, the Church wisely allowed the blessing to be led by a member of the household itself. In this way, parents take up their rightful role as the first witnesses of faith within the home, invoking God's protection and presence where daily family life unfolds.

This custom has deep biblical roots. In the Book of Exodus, the Lord commanded the Israelites to mark the lintels of their homes with the blood of the Passover lamb, a sign of protection and deliverance. In a similar way, the Epiphany blessing marks our doorways as places where Christ is welcomed, honored, and invited to dwell among us always. The doorway becomes a threshold not only of our home, but of faith.

On the Solemnity of the Epiphany, chalk is traditionally blessed with a prayer, as we will do at all weekend Masses, asking that those who inscribe the names of the Magi—Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar—may enjoy health of body and protection of soul through their intercession. This blessed chalk is then taken home and used in faith. The Church, like a good mother, gives us these sacramentals to strengthen us on the path to salvation and to remind us that God's grace is meant to touch even the ordinary spaces of our lives.

After praying the Epiphany blessing at home, families mark the inside of their front door with the current year and the initials of the Magi, traditionally written like this:

20 C+M+B 26

The crosses remind us that every blessing flows from the Cross of Christ. The initials recall the Wise Men who sought and found the Lord. Many Christians have also understood these letters to mean *Christus mansionem benedicat*—"May Christ bless this house."

This simple act is a quiet but powerful profession of faith. It says to everyone who enters, and reminds ourselves, that this home belongs to Christ, that He is welcome here, and that we trust in His protection. In a world often marked by anxiety and uncertainty, such a blessing is a reminder that God is always with us.

I encourage every family in the parish to take part in this tradition. Use the prayers provided, mark your doorway with blessed chalk, and invite Christ to reign anew in your household this Epiphany. Like the Magi, may we open our doors, offer what we have, and adore the Lord who has come to save us.



Epiphany

Every year, the students preparing for First Holy Communion would present a Christmas Pageant for the parish on Christmas Eve, before Mass. One year, the teacher was going to wait until a day or two before the presentation to teach the three young magi their names. Unfortunately, she got sick and the new director simply asked the young actors if they knew their names. Assured they did, she discovered the importance of specific questions and answers when, during the pageant, the magi announced their names as Manny, Moe and Jack!

So who were the Magi anyway? Why do they appear for a brief moment in the Gospel and then disappear? They don't really. Those who have gone before us leave an example for us to follow. Their virtues and sins, their doubts and certainties are our own. As part of one People of God, we join with them in seeking and finding the way, the truth and the light.

In a sense, we present the story of the magi in our life of faith. Our names are announced at baptism and we begin the journey as we follow the Lord, guided by the church, nourished by sacraments, and supported by one another. Throughout our lives, we bear the gifts of faith, hope and love, ready to present them to the Lord at journey's end. We seek the Lord where He may be found, and invite others to join us in our quest.


