

From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I want to begin with a sincere word of gratitude. Week after week, your generosity to our parish is a powerful sign of your love for Christ and His Church. Thanks to your faithful support, our weekly offertory has continued to improve, moving us closer to our goal of approximately \$21,000 per week, which covers about 90 percent of our ordinary operating expenses. I am deeply grateful for the sacrifices you make to sustain the life and mission of our parish.

At the same time, we all know that the practical needs of parish life continue to grow. This winter alone, Christ the King expects to spend approximately \$75,000 on heating our churches and plowing our parking lots. In addition, as you may recall, the entire Christmas collection is directed to the Boston Clergy Trust, meaning those funds do not remain at the parish. For these reasons, this weekend we take up our **New Year Kickoff Collection**, which will help us meet these seasonal needs and begin the year on firm footing. Please note that this is an additional donation we are asking for on top of the regular weekly offertory. The red and white envelopes can be placed in the basket at collection time or returned to the parish office in the weeks ahead. You may also make your donation on the parish website or by Venmo by scanning the QR codes in the bulletin.

I think it's fitting that this collection coincides with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. In His baptism, Jesus enters the waters not because He needs to for His own sake, but to sanctify the waters themselves and to show us the way. Through our baptism, we are made sons and daughters of the Father, members of the Body of Christ, and brothers and sisters to one another. We are not isolated individuals, but one family united in Christ.

Pope Leo beautifully captures this truth in his motto, *In Illo uno unum* — “In Him who is One, we are one.” United in Christ, we share not only faith and worship, but also responsibility for one another and for the life of our parish. Each gift, whether large or small, is an expression of that unity and a tangible way of living out our baptismal call.

Thank you for your continued generosity, your prayers, and your love for our parish family. May the Lord, who was baptized for our sake, bless you abundantly and strengthen our unity in Him.


