From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

How about those Patriots! Let's hope for two more wins, starting this weekend in Denver!

Here's a little Gospel reflection for the week. Enjoy!

In today's Gospel, Jesus begins His public ministry after His baptism, and Saint Matthew reminds us that He is the fulfillment of Isaiah's promise: *"The people who sit in darkness have seen a great light."* Christ Himself is of course that light—the light of truth and hope that scatters darkness and leads us to life.

What is striking is whom Jesus first calls to share this light. Not the powerful or the learned, but ordinary fishermen—Peter, Andrew, James, and John. They heard His call, left everything behind, and followed Him immediately. As Pope Saint John Paul II beautifully said, *"These men experienced the fascination of the hidden light that emanated from Him, and they followed Him without delay so that their path through life might shine with His brightness. But that light of Jesus shines out for everyone."*

Jesus never stops calling disciples. He calls us—right where we are—to follow Him and to reflect His light to a world that so often walks in confusion and darkness. Faith in Christ is not meant to be kept to ourselves. It is the remedy for a wounded world, and it grows when we stay close to Him: through prayer, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the Eucharist, fidelity to the Church, and a courageous witness in daily life.

Friends, the Lord wants each of us to take part in His saving mission. If we respond generously to His call, beginning here with faithful Sunday worship, the Kingdom of God will be made visible in our midst. May we be true disciples—men and women who carry and share the greatest light of all, Jesus Christ, our Savior.

January 25 ~ Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



Today’s readings describe the characteristics and work of disciples. Isaiah reminds us that we no longer walk in darkness. For us, the ‘great light’ he speaks of is Jesus Christ. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges the community to “be united in the same mind and in the same purpose” and “let there be no division among you.” In the gospel, Jesus invites the first Apostles: “Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.” Do you see yourself as a fisher of men/women? God invites us to bring his light, his peace and reconciliation to the many and varied relationships in our lives. Reread today’s scriptures, ask for the grace to take God’s word to heart and let it reflect in our words and actions!




