

## From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

Thank you for your fidelity to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass last weekend. I was edified to see how many of you came to the Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses before the arrival of the winter storm. Worshipping God as a community is the heart of our life together as a parish because it unites us more deeply in the Body of Christ. At Mass, we do not come as isolated individuals but as one family, gathered around one altar, nourished by the one Bread of Life. In receiving the Eucharist, Christ Himself draws us into communion with God and with one another, forming us into a living sign of His presence in the world. This unity is not something we manufacture; it is something we receive as a gift when we faithfully place ourselves before the Lord.

As I read today's Gospel (Matthew 5:1-12a) my mind returned to a moment from a few years ago, when I had the extraordinary grace of celebrating Mass on the Mount of Beatitudes in the Holy Land. Standing there, overlooking the Sea of Galilee, I was struck by the simplicity of the place and the depth of the words Jesus spoke there. It is one thing to read the Sermon on the Mount in Scripture; it is another to proclaim it where those words first echoed across the hills and into the hearts of the disciples.

On that mountain, it became clear to me that the Beatitudes are often misunderstood. One flawed way of reading them is to hear them merely as a list of moral demands that we must somehow accomplish through sheer willpower. That approach misses the heart of what Jesus is doing. Our Lord is not handing His disciples an impossible checklist; He is revealing a portrait of the transformed human person. In effect, He is saying: *This is what your life begins to look like as I increasingly live My life in you.*

The Beatitudes can feel so strange to us. On the surface, they sound almost foolish. Hungering and thirsting, mourning, meekness, persecution—these hardly resemble the world's definition of happiness. And yet, as Saint Paul reminds us, "God chose the foolish of the world to shame the wise." God's ways are not our ways. The world tells us that happiness comes from wealth, power, admiration, comfort, and control. Jesus, standing on that mountain, proclaims a radically different path.

The word *beatitude* means a state of deepest blessedness. The Beatitudes, then, are not burdens placed upon us, but a roadmap offered to us—a revelation of what true happiness looks like when God's grace is at work in a human heart. Jesus is not saying, "Make yourself poor, meek, or merciful, and then God will love you." Rather, He is saying that when we allow His grace to shape us—when He brings about in us poverty of spirit, mercy, purity of heart—we begin to experience the profound joy of a life that is truly flourishing.

Beatitude is always the work of God. It is something we receive, not something we achieve. Just as at Mass we come forward with empty hands to receive the Eucharist, so too we come before the Lord with open hearts, allowing Him to transform us from within. The Beatitudes describe what a person looks like who has yielded to that saving work of Christ.

As we continue this week, may our participation in the Holy Mass strengthen our unity as a parish and renew our openness to the grace of God. And may the words spoken by Jesus on the Mount of Beatitudes draw us ever more deeply into the blessed life He desires for us.

Lastly, if you would like to stand on the Mount of Beatitudes and ponder Jesus' words where He first spoke them, consider joining me on the Holy Land Pilgrimage. Details are in the bulletin!
