



From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend, for this year's annual Missionary Co-Op Appeal, it is a great joy for me to welcome Fr. Thomas Hagan, an Oblate of St. Francis de Sales, who will be preaching at all of the Masses and sharing about his ministry in Haiti through his nonprofit *Hands Together*. I am grateful that Fr. Hagan is with us, and I ask you to extend to him a warm and generous welcome.

Fr. Hagan has spent nearly three decades serving the people of Port-au-Prince, particularly in Cité Soleil, one of the poorest and most dangerous places in the Western Hemisphere. In 1986, he founded *Hands Together*, a Catholic nonprofit that provides education, healthcare, pastoral care, food assistance, clean water, and outreach to the elderly. Today, *Hands Together* operates multiple school campuses, a free medical clinic, senior housing, and agricultural and water programs in rural Haiti, while employing hundreds of Haitians who depend on this ministry for their livelihood.

Despite the extreme violence, instability, and hardship facing Haiti, Fr. Hagan has remained committed to his people. His ministry requires him to travel through dangerous gang-controlled areas, because he believes deeply in standing with those he serves. His witness is a powerful reminder of the Gospel lived out with courage, compassion, and trust in God.


There will be a second collection this weekend to support *Hands Together*. Please use the baskets located at the entrances of the churches. Your generosity will help provide food, education, clean water, and hope to families who are struggling daily just to survive. I encourage you to listen closely to Fr. Hagan's preaching, greet him personally if you are able, and prayerfully consider how you might support this vital mission.

I also want to thank everyone who participated in the two Parish Feedback Sessions held last weekend. I am very grateful for the thoughtful, honest, and prayerful input that was shared. The Pastoral Planning Committee and I will be providing parish-wide updates next weekend, summarizing what we heard and outlining next steps as we continue to discern where the Holy Spirit is leading us together.

Thank you for your faith, your generosity, and your continued commitment to our parish and to the wider mission of the Church.







February 8 ~ Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

The darkness and cold of winter still surround us making very relevant to our spiritual lives the theme of light and darkness in today's readings. In the first reading, Isaiah reminds us that performing any work of mercy brings light into the darkness of our hearts and the world. Jesus, in speaking to the disciples and to us says, "You are the light of the world.... your light must shine before others. . ." As baptized children of God, we carry the light of Christ within us. It is important for us to reflect on whether our words and actions reflect the light of Christ. If they do not, what change will you make so that Christ's light shines for others to see? By doing that, you have the power to diminish the darkness that exists around you!




