## *From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy First Sunday of Lent!

Each year the Church invites us to enter into this sacred season — a season of grace, a season of renewal, and a season of transformation. Lent is not simply about giving something up; it is about making room for God. Through the disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we open our hearts more fully to His presence and allow Him to transform us from within. Prayer draws us closer to God and strengthens our relationship with Him. Fasting teaches us self-discipline and helps us detach from the things of this world so that we can hunger more deeply for God. Almsgiving turns our hearts outward in love and reminds us to care for those in need, seeing Christ in others.

In a particular way this year, Pope Leo XIV has offered us a powerful and very practical Lenten invitation that I think is worth our reflection. He writes:

*I would like to invite you to a very practical and frequently unappreciated form of abstinence: that of refraining from words that offend and hurt our neighbor. Let us begin by disarming our language, avoiding harsh words and rash judgement, refraining from slander and speaking ill of those who are not present and cannot defend themselves. Instead, let us strive to measure our words and cultivate kindness and respect in our families, among our friends, at work, on social media, in political debates, in the media and in Christian communities. In this way, words of hatred will give way to words of hope and peace.*

Our parish will offer many opportunities to help you enter more deeply into this holy season. Each Friday during Lent, we will pray the **Stations of the Cross** at 6:30pm, followed by a simple soup supper. Walking with Christ along the way of the Cross reminds us of the depth of His love for us and invites us to unite our own sufferings with His.

On March 14, we will host a **Lenten Day of Prayer**, led by my good friend Fr. Patrick O'Connor. This will be a beautiful opportunity for reflection, prayer, and spiritual renewal. We will also have **Nocturnal Eucharistic Adoration** from March 20–21, offering an opportunity to spend time in the quiet presence of Our Lord. And of course, **the sacrament of Confession** will be available regularly throughout Lent. Confession is one of the greatest gifts Christ has given us — an opportunity to encounter His mercy and begin anew. If it's been a while since you've received this sacrament, please make a point to come soon!

During this Lenten season, you will also notice that we will be chant certain parts of the Mass in English – the Kyrie (Lord have mercy), the Holy, Holy, Holy, the Memorial Acclamation, and the Lamb of God. Chant has been part of the Church's prayer from the very beginning as it unites us as one voice. I encourage you not simply to listen to these chants, but to take part in them. Allow these prayers to come from your heart. In a special way during Lent, these chants help us express repentance and trust in God's mercy.

Friends, Lent is a journey, and the Lord desires to do something new in each one of us. More than anything, He desires to transform our hearts. I invite you to enter this season with openness and generosity – to pray more deeply, to fast with purpose, and to serve others with true charity. If we live Lent well, when Easter arrives, we may rejoice not only in His Resurrection, but in the new life He has brought about within us!





**February 22** ~ The first Sunday of Lent always begins with the reminder that Jesus was tempted, just as we are. 




