## From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

A blessed Laetare Sunday to all of you!

Each year, the Archdiocese of Boston invites us to participate in the Catholic Appeal, an opportunity for us to support the mission of the Church not only in our own parish but throughout the entire Archdiocese. The Appeal helps sustain many ministries, programs, and services that serve thousands of people across our region and strengthen the life of the Church in ways that are often unseen but deeply important.

During my time at Christ the King Parish, I have personally experienced the value of the offices and ministries supported by the Catholic Appeal. In my role as pastor, I have relied on several Archdiocesan departments funded through the Appeal, including human resources, risk management, IT, and finance. These services provide essential support for our parish and allow me to dedicate more of my time and energy to the spiritual care of our parish community.

The Appeal also supports important ministries such as the vocations office, which assists men discerning a call to the priesthood, as well as the permanent diaconate formation program. These ministries ensure that the Church continues to raise up faithful servants who will guide and serve God's people in the years ahead.

At the same time, the Catholic Appeal reminds us that we are part of something much larger than our own parish. When we make a pledge to the Appeal, we stand in unity with Catholics across the Archdiocese of Boston. Together, we help support the needs of the wider Church and care for our brothers and sisters—especially those who rely on the Church's ministries for spiritual, educational, and charitable support.
