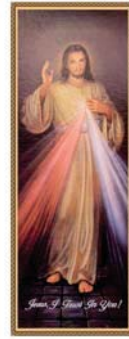



**April 12 ~Second Sunday of Easter (Sunday of Divine Mercy)** This Sunday, our scriptures give us clear instruction about how we are to live as disciples. In the reading from Acts, the author describes the disciples' way of life: "They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of bread and to the prayers." Teaching, prayer and Eucharist, sound familiar? Nourished by prayer and our reception of Holy Communion may we be strengthened to bring the peace and mercy of Christ to others. 

**A PRAYER FOR THOSE WHO LEFT THE CHURCH**

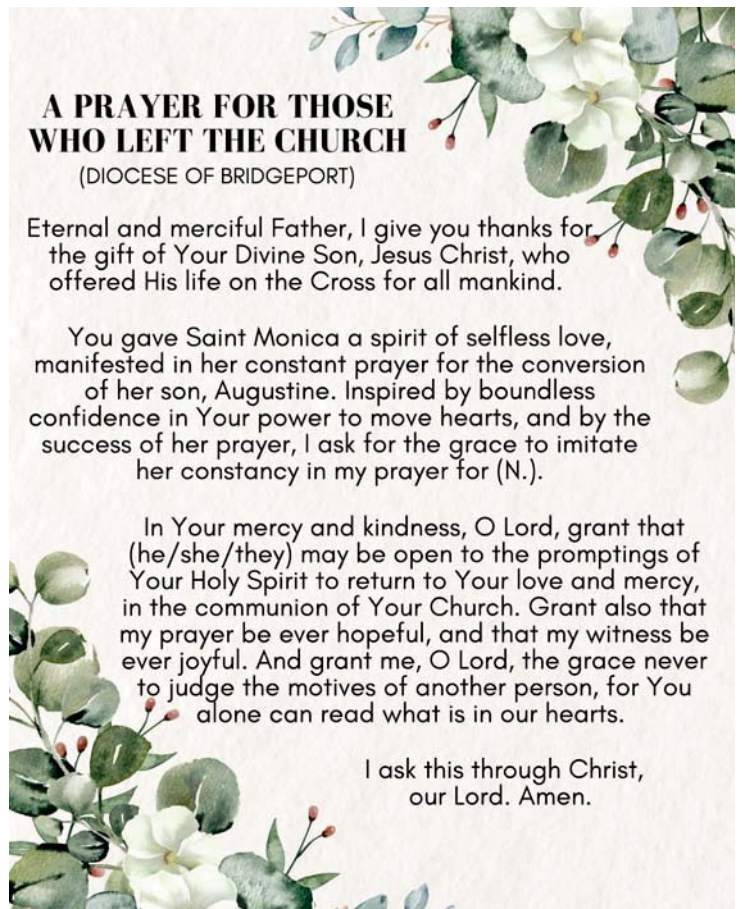
