Special Collection for Venezuela — July 4/5

Noting the immense suffering and loss of life occurring in Venezuela following devastating earthquakes, Archbishop Richard G. Henning has asked parishes to take up a special collection to aid relief efforts.

The Catholic Church, through Catholic Relief Services (CRS), is working through Caritas Venezuela and the local Church "to quickly deliver emergency shelter, food, safe water, medical care and other critical relief to those affected." CRS reports that "Buildings collapsed, homes and essential infrastructure were damaged, and thousands of people have been left without safe shelter. Even as the full extent of the damage is still emerging, Catholic parishes have opened their doors to shelter displaced families and provide emergency assistance."

With the death toll approaching 1,000 and likely to surpass that, more than 3,000 having been injured and thousands more missing, the Church has mobilized and is bringing immediate relief to the people impacted. "The size and scope of the crisis is enormous, and the need will only grow in the hours, days and weeks ahead," said the Archbishop.

For this special collection, parishioners are asked to address their checks to their parish, with "Venezuela Relief" in the memo. Archbishop Henning said, "through the intercession of Our Lady of Coromoto, Patroness of Venezuela, may God grant strength, comfort, healing, peace and hope to all during this difficult time."

From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

As I'm sure you know, this weekend, our nation celebrates the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. For two and a half centuries, Americans have given thanks for the freedoms that have shaped our nation—freedom of speech, freedom of religion, freedom of assembly, and so many other liberties that we rightly cherish and seek to protect.

Religious liberty is a gift that allows us to gather for Mass, proclaim the Gospel, and live our faith openly. We thank God for all who have sacrificed throughout our nation's history to preserve these freedoms.

At the same time, our Catholic faith invites us to reflect more deeply on what freedom truly is.

In today's world, freedom is often understood as the ability to do whatever we want, whenever we want, without anyone telling us otherwise. While freedom certainly includes the ability to make our own choices, the Church teaches that authentic freedom is something much greater.

The *Catechism* reminds us, "The more one does what is good, the freer one becomes. There is no true freedom except in the service of what is good and just. The choice to disobey and do evil is an abuse of freedom and leads to 'the slavery of sin.'" (CCC 1733).

For many, this idea of freedom may sound surprising. We tend to think that rules limit freedom, but the opposite is often true. Consider a gifted musician. The freedom to play beautiful music doesn't come from ignoring the rules of music but from years of disciplined practice. An athlete experiences the freedom to excel only after countless hours of training. In much the same way, the Christian life teaches us that virtue, that is, the habitual and firm disposition to do the good, does not restrict our freedom—it perfects it.

Pope Saint John Paul II spoke often about this. He reminded us that freedom can never be separated from truth. If we use our freedom to reject what is good, we don't become more free—we become enslaved by sin. True freedom is the freedom to love, to serve, to forgive, to choose what is right, and ultimately to become the person God created us to be.

Jesus Himself tells us, "If you remain in my word, you will truly be my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31-32). Thus, for us Catholics, it is only in following Christ that we discover the fullness of freedom for which our hearts long.

As we gather with family and friends this Independence Day, enjoying cookouts, parades, fireworks, and time together, let us thank God not only for the blessings of our nation but also for the even greater gift of the freedom Christ has won for us through His Death and Resurrection. May we never take either gift for granted.

Let us also use this as an opportunity to pray for our country, especially in this anniversary year. May God continue to bless the United States of America. May He grant wisdom to those who govern us, protect those who serve our nation, and help each of us use our freedom not merely for own interest, but in loving service to God and to one another.

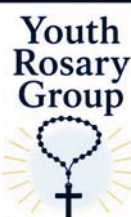


OCIA Sacramental Preparation

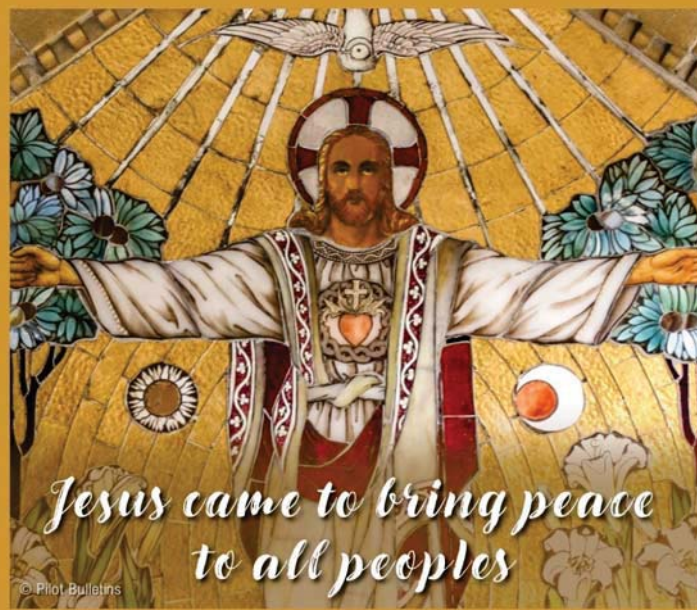

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A

First Reading — Zechariah 9:9-10: The prophet says a king will come to Jerusalem. He will be good and bring victory. But he will also be humble, riding on a donkey. He will bring peace to all nations. His rule will reach everywhere.

Responsorial Psalm — Psalm 145: We praise God for his kindness and mercy. He helps those who fall. He is faithful in all he does. His followers thank him and tell of his greatness.
