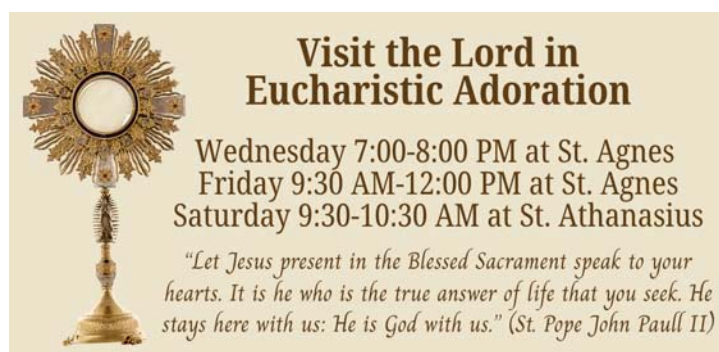

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From the Pastor, Fr. Bobby LeBlanc

Dear Friends in Christ,

This past Friday we celebrated the Memorial of Saint Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus, better known as the Jesuits. His feast day always reminds me of his beautiful *Suscipe* (Latin for "Receive") prayer that I prayed every weekday for six years while studying at St. John's Seminary.

Each day at noon, the seminarians would gather in the chapel to pray the Angelus, the Examen, and the *Suscipe* prayer before lunch. The Examen gave us an opportunity to reflect on the day and recognize where God had been present and at work in our lives. Over time, I came to love the *Suscipe* Prayer, and it has remained one of my favorites ever since:

*Take, O Lord, and receive
my entire liberty, my memory, my understanding,
and my whole will.
All that I am and all that I possess,
You have given me:
I surrender it all to You
to be disposed of according to Your will.
Give me only Your love and Your grace;
with these I will be rich enough,
and will desire nothing more. Amen.*

I love this prayer because it reminds us of a simple but profound truth: everything we have comes from the goodness of God. Our life, our freedom, our intellect, our memory, our talents, our possessions—even our ability to love—are all gifts from Him. We are not the owners of these gifts but their stewards. In this prayer, Saint Ignatius invites us to place everything back into God's hands, reminding us that true peace comes not from controlling our lives but from entrusting them to the One who loves us perfectly.

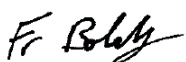
The final lines of the prayer are especially striking: "*Give me only Your love and Your grace; with these I will be rich enough, and will desire nothing more.*" What a radical statement in a world that constantly tells us we need more—more success, more possessions, more recognition, more security. On the contrary, if we possess God's love and live in His grace, we already have everything that truly matters. Everything else is secondary.

Now, imagine beginning each morning with this prayer before checking your phone, opening your email, or heading off to work. Imagine placing your plans, your worries, your family, your successes, your disappointments, and everything you have into the Lord's hands. Day after day, this simple act of surrender would gradually reshape the heart. We would become less anxious, less attached to the things that pass away, and more confident in God's loving providence.

I encourage you to consider adding the *Suscipe* prayer to your own "prayer arsenal." It takes less than a minute to pray, but its impact can be immeasurable. There is something powerful about praying the same beautiful prayers consistently. Over time, their meaning begins to seep into our souls. They move from our lips into our hearts, and eventually into the way we live. We begin not only to recite the words but to believe them—and, by God's grace, to live them.

May Saint Ignatius of Loyola teach us the freedom that comes from surrendering everything to Jesus Christ. For when we place ourselves completely in His hands, we discover that His love and His grace truly are enough.

Sinking Fear

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A)

1 Kings 19:9, 11-13 | Psalm 85:9-14 | Romans 9:1-5 | Matthew 14:22-33

How do we find God in the storms and struggles of our lives, in the trials we encounter in trying to do His will?

God commands Elijah in today's First Reading to stand on the mountain and await His passing by. And in the Gospel, Jesus makes the disciples set out across the waters to meet Him. In each case, the Lord makes himself present amid frightening tumult - heavy winds and high waves, fire and earthquakes. Elijah hides his face. Perhaps he remembers Moses, who met God on the same mountain, also amid fire, thunder, and smoke (see Deuteronomy 4:10-15; Exodus 19:17-19). God told Moses no one could see His face and live, and He sheltered Moses in the hollow of a rock, as He shelters Elijah in a cave (see Exodus 33:18-23).

The disciples, likewise, are too terrified to look on the face of God. Today's Gospel is a revelation of Jesus' divine identity. Only God treads across the crest of the sea (see Job 9:8) and rules the raging waters (see Psalm 89:9-10). And the words of assurance that Jesus speaks - "It is I" - are those God used to identify himself to Moses (see Exodus 3:14; Isaiah 43:10). Even Peter is too overcome by fear to imitate his Lord. His fears, Jesus tells him, are a sign of his lack of faith. And so it often is with us. Our fears make us doubt, make it hard to see His glory dwelling in our midst.

Yet, we should know, as we sing in today's psalm, that His salvation is near to those who hope in Him. By faith we should know, as Paul asserts in today's Epistle, that we are heirs to the promises made to His children, Israel. We must trust that He whispers to us in the trials of our lives - that He who has called us to walk along the way of His steps, will save us whenever we begin to sink.

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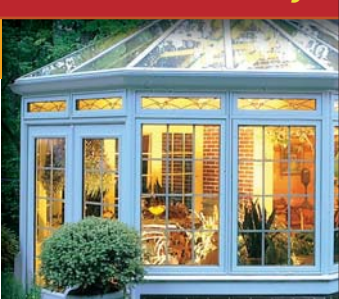


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
