A Spiritual Home

Christ the King Parish is more than buildings or programs—it is a home. We walk with people from baptism to burial, supporting parishioners at every stage of life.

Families and Faith Formation

Families are at the center of parish life. As the domestic church, parents are the first teachers of the faith. We are building pathways of faith for all generations.

- Family Faith Formation (K–6): A new model uniting families in Gospel living.
- Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: Montessori-based formation nurturing a child’s relationship with God. A dedicated atrium space is a desired space in our community.
- Confirmation Preparation (Grades 7–8): Rooted in prayer, service, and Church teaching, with new parent involvement.
- Youth & Young Adults: New and growing communities for high school students, young adults (20s–30s), and young couples.

Adult Faith Formation

We have great groups for formation and fellowship among our adult communities.
