OAKLAND DIOCESE CYO CROSS COUNTRY BIBS / NAME TAGS / PARISH CODES FOR NAME TAGS

For the First Meet and Diocesan Meets (Bibs Required): Coordinators must register their runners on the provided form one week prior to each of these meets. On arrival, the coordinator will pick up a packet with a bib for each runner showing an assigned number containing a chip, along with safety pins. The bib must be pinned to the corresponding runner's chest. The bibs do not need to be returned.

For the Second and Fourth Meets (Nametags Required): As in previous seasons, each participant must wear a removable nametag with: First AND Last Name, Parish/School Team, Gender and assigned number from the first meet, clearly indicated. It is recommended that runners ALSO wear their numbered bibs from the first meet for identification. Teams must use the designated codes (below) for parish/school names. Teams should bring their own nametags.

Note: Nametags should be **1-1/4** " or less in height and legible.

For the Relay Meet: Only the anchor runner should wear a removable nametag with name of parish team indicated. Mixed parish teams will receive a nametag. No bibs are necessary.

The following are name codes for parishes/schools that may be competing this year - this is how the school names should appear on the runners' labels and in the "school" column on the race results pages. This will greatly aid in producing accurate results!
