FR. DEL... POINTS TO PONDER



Catholics place a strong emphasis on **The Communion of Saints**, emphasized throughout the month of November, beginning with The Solemnity of All Saints on November 1, and All Souls on November 2.



The first of these days focuses especially on those holy men and women who have been officially recognized by the Church, but

not exclusively. The second is our awareness that from the moment God thought of us until Christ comes at the end of time, we are journeying to see God face to face.

The Communion of Saints is our way of recognizing that the Church of Heaven and the Church of Earth constitutes the one Church of Christ. This awareness leads us to pray for our beloved dead, and ask those who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith, to pray for us. In short, we intercede for one another that we may all come to know the great mercy of God, wherever we find ourselves on the sojourn of faith in Christ.

Solemnity of All Saints – A Holy Day of Obligation, is celebrated on Wednesday, November 1st.

Masses at **St. Veronica** will be celebrated 7:30 a.m.; 9:00 a.m. (school).

Masses at **St. Elizabeth Ann Seton** will be celebrated at 8:45 a.m. and 12:00 Noon.

Mass at **St. Andrew** will be celebrated at 7:00 p.m.

On this day, we implore all the Saints to intercede for us in our need, as well as joining with the "throne of heaven" to praise God for His mercy.

Remembering Our Beloved Dead – On Saturday, November 4, at St. Veronica and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton during our Saturday evening Mass, we will be remembering by name all of those who have died from our parish in the past year. At St. Andrew, we will remember those who have died at the 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, November 5. Families who have lost loved ones since November 1 of last year, have all been invited to carry a candle to the front of church as the Mass begins. OH, NOW
I GET IT!

What in the world are next
Sunday's readings about?

THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Mal 1: 14b-2:2b, 8-10 God condemns the Jewish priests for compromising the principles of their office by offering unfit sacrifices such as offering defective animals instead of the best of the flock, and by giving scandal by such as showing preference when rendering judgments in disputes. **COVENANT OF LEVI:** Jewish priests were the descendants of the tribe of Jacob's son, Levi. (Sadly, unworthy behavior of priests was not restricted to the Jewish priesthood.)

1 Thes 2:7b, 9-13 Paul often seems to brag about his dedication to his mission, but his point here is to say that his hard work has paid off. Paul saw anything that sounded like boasting not to be about his own efforts, but the work of Christ through him. The Thessalonians see his human words are actually the Word of God, which continues to work in them.

Mt 23:1-12 Jesus blatantly condemns the scribes and the Pharisees (who are not Jewish priests, but see themselves as teachers of the Law [the Mosaic Covenant]) for three corrupt behaviors. 1. Not practicing what they preach; Jesus distinguishes between the truth of their teaching and their infidelity to living it, and calls the people to follow the teaching but not the half-hearted examples. 2. Creating heavy burdens of faith and doing nothing to help the hearer. A true religious teacher not only announces the law, but helps to live it out. 3. These groups use the elements of religious devotion not to give witness to the faith, for their own self-aggrandizement and ego. **PHYLACTERIES:** Little boxes containing a Scripture passage worn by devout Jews on the forearm or forehead to keep memory of the Covenant close to them. **TASSELS:** on cloaks to remind the people of the Commandments. Instead of means of growing in fidelity to God, they are used to promote self-importance. Jesus tells His followers to not use titles for their own advantage. His command not to call oneself a teacher (rabbi), father, or master was not taken literally, even by the early Church; but used in the context of realizing who is the true Father, Master, and Teacher, who is God Himself. Paul writes that he is like Timothy's father, (Phil 2: 22) and he calls himself Onesimus' father. (Pm 10) Ultimately, any instrument of faith is to be used solely for the sake of the Gospel and not for the sake of the minister.

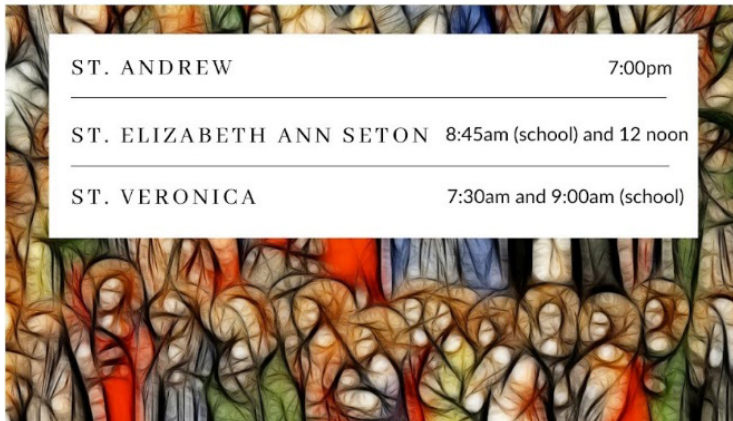

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

The **Sacrament of Baptism for infants** is scheduled on Sundays either at Mass or at 12:30 p.m. Expectant parents should plan on attending the Baptismal Preparation Program, held six times a year. Call the Parish Office to schedule the Baptism and Preparation Program.

The **Sacrament of Baptism for adults and school-age children** is usually celebrated at the Easter Vigil, along with the **Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist**. Preparation occurs in steps and stages throughout the year. Call Elizabeth Otte at 513-882-6515 for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

The **Sacrament of Penance** (Reconciliation or Confession) is celebrated each Saturday, 2:30-3:30 p.m., or by appointment with the pastor. Seasonal Penance Services are also celebrated.

The **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick** may be scheduled by calling the pastor before a medical procedure, or in the event of a serious illness, and **after all Masses when there are five weekends in the month**. When hospitalized, please notify the Parish Office; this is the only way we know if a parishioner has been hospitalized. In case of medical emergency or death, call the Parish Office and follow prompts.

SACRAMENTS OF COMMITMENT

The **Sacrament of Marriage** is scheduled by calling the pastor or deacon to begin the process of marriage preparation at least six months prior to the anticipated wedding date. A date for the wedding is set only after meeting with the pastor or deacon.
