FR. DEL... POINTS TO PONDER



The place of Mary in Salvation is an important role to understand, especially as we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. What Catholic has not been confronted, sometimes accosted with the question, "Why do Catholics worship Mary?" To be sure, we do not worship Mary. The reality is that many people, Catholics and non-Catholics alike, do not make the distinction between worship and honor. We only worship God. We do honor great examples of people who follow God; Mary is the primary model of one who worshipped God with every fiber of her being. Mary

magnified God in her total submission to God's will for her by her saying, "yes," to the role that God had pre-ordained for her.

It is interesting to note that when the fathers of the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965) discussed the role of Mary, they placed her role in the *Dogmatic Constitution on the Church*, in Latin, *Lumen Gentium* (Light to the Nations). This placement made the dramatic statement that Mary's role in the life of the Church is integral to our life in Christ. Two statements stand out:

"The Father of mercies willed that the incarnation should be preceded by the acceptance of her who was predestined to be the mother of His Son, so that just as a woman contributed to death, so also a woman should contribute to life." (LG #56)

"For no creature could ever be counted as equal with the Incarnate Word and Redeemer. Just as the priesthood of Christ is shared in various ways, both by the ministers and by the faithful, and as the one goodness of God is really communicated in different ways to His creatures, so also the unique mediation of the Redeemer does not exclude, but rather gives rise to a manifold cooperation, which is but a sharing in this one source." (LG #67)

Mary is our model in faith because she is what we hope to become by our turning our will and our lives over to the care of God. Mary, the New Eve, shows us how to respond appropriately to God's life.

There is a famous story about a group who came to visit President Abraham Lincoln before the Civil War and started to warn him that they would win the war because God was on their side. Lincoln responded, "It is more important to know that we are on God's side."

We can spend so much time asking God to come into our hopes and dreams, our requests and situations, that we fail to ask God what he wants us to do. Do we know God's side? Mary did. Our honor of Mary is placed in the very life of the Church because she contributed to God's life in the Mystery of Salvation.

The Incarnation, God choosing to show holiness in and through human beings, is God's statement that he is on our side. Are we on God's?

Have you ever thought at Mass, "What in the world is this reading about?" Each week, you can learn some background to make sense of the Scripture for the next Sunday that may be hard to understand.



EPIPHANY OF THE LORD EPIPHANY: revelation

Is 60:1-6 The Jewish people, vanquished and exiled, hear that God will raise them up and glorify them as all the nations will come to them guided by the light.

Psalm 72:1-2, 7-13 Heard in light of Jesus as the King of kings (even greater than Elvis). v. 10-12: Kings will come to pay him homage. (This is where the idea of the Magi as kings comes from.)

Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6 God fully reveals through the apostles and prophets that salvation is for the Gentile (i.e., all people).

Mt 2:1-12 The Magi, learned advisors to kings, seek truth as they know how, by studying the stars and following THE star. Herod works against the truth because he fears it threatens his earthy power and glory. Gold, frankincense, myrrh: not practical gifts for a baby, but gifts suited to a king in the Old Testament.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK:

The Magi respond to Jesus with gifts from their "treasures." What treasures (spiritual or material) might you place at the service of Christ?


FREE LIVE CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

MASS IN ROME AROUND 700 CE



- Parents must be committed to being, and raising their child, as an active parishioner.



SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is scheduled on Sundays, either at Mass or at 12:30 p.m. Expectant parents should plan on attending the Baptismal Preparation Program, held six times a year. Call the Parish Office to schedule the Baptism and Preparation

The Sacrament of Baptism for adults and school-age children is usually celebrated at the Easter Vigil, along with the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist. Preparation occurs in steps and stages throughout the year. Call Elizabeth Otte at 513-882-6515 for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

The Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation or Confession) is celebrated each Saturday, 2:30-3:30 p.m., or by appointment with the pastor. Seasonal Penance Services are also celebrated.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick may be scheduled by calling the pastor before a medical procedure, or in the event of a serious illness, and after all Masses when there are five weekends in the month. When hospitalized, please notify the Parish Office; this is the only way we know if a parishioner has been hospitalized. In case of medical emergency or death, call the Parish Office and follow prompts. **SACRAMENTS OF COMMITMENT**

The Sacrament of Marriage is scheduled by calling the pastor or deacon to begin the process of marriage preparation at least six months prior to the anticipated wedding date. A date for the wedding is set only after meeting with the pastor or deacon.

Discernment for the Sacrament of Orders (ordination to the Priesthood and Diaconate) is facilitated by contacting the pastor or Vocation Director of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Those interested in pursuing Religious Life may also make these contacts.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Religious Education Program (Family of Faith) for children (Age 3 years through 8th Grade) begins each year in September and ends in May. Call Lori Anne Fothergill, Director of Faith Formation, at 513-528-1622, ext. 111, for more information.
