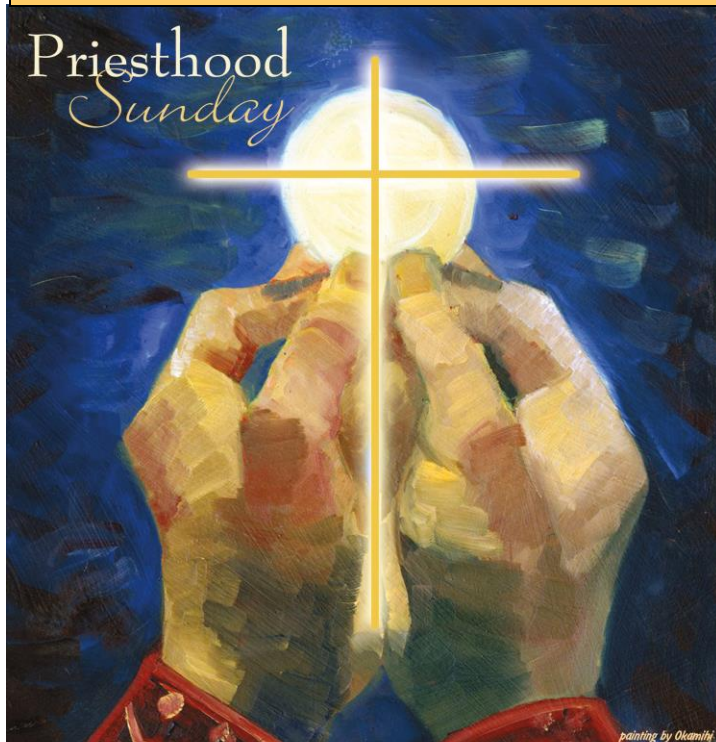

10th.

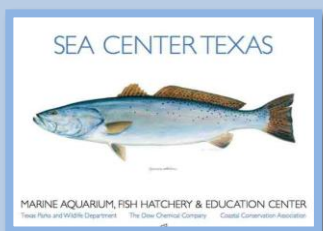
Each ministry will set up a table in the

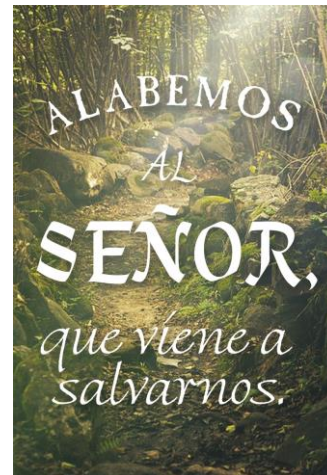
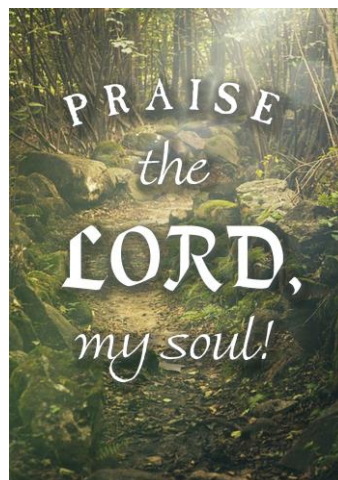

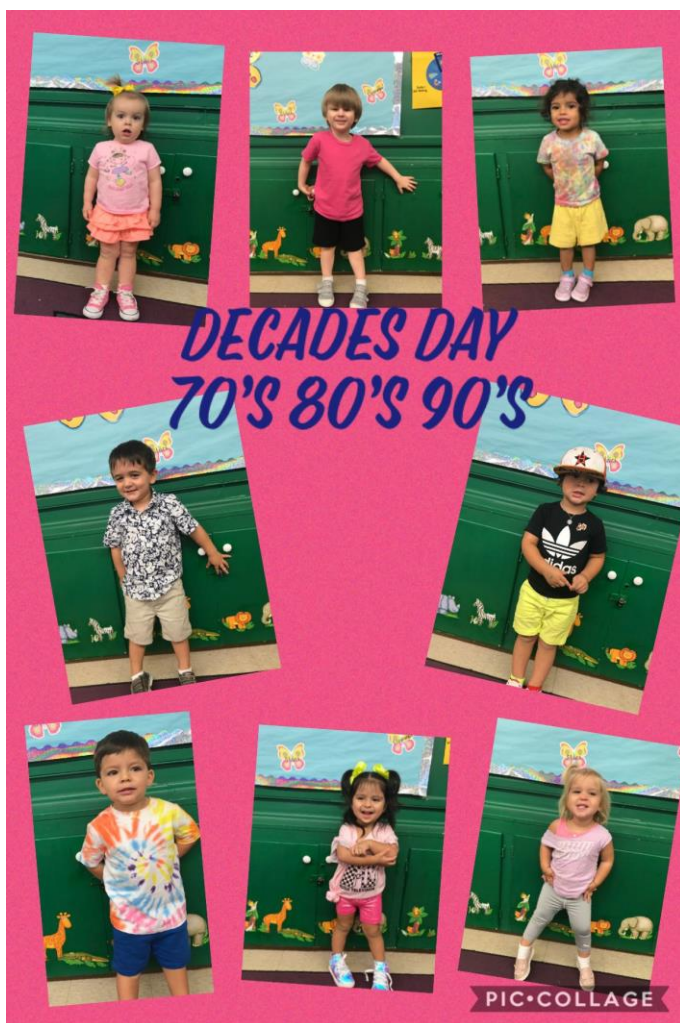
