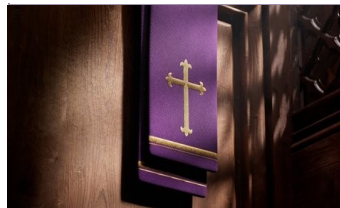

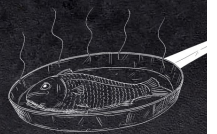

WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is a period of **fasting**, **moderation**, and **self-denial**. It is the season in which we **focus** on **examining** our hearts, **confess** our sins, and **reflect** on the significance of Christ's death.



This time of fasting opens the gates of heaven to us. Let us welcome it and pray that when Easter comes we may share the joy of the risen Lord.

WHEN IS LENT?

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Thursday.

It lasts for 40 days (not counting Sundays).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO DURING LENT?

1. Turn away from our sins and turn back to God. Detach from habits and tendencies that are contrary to God's will. Lent is a time of conversion.
2. Open our hearts to our Father, so that we may live with Christ for God. Jesus is calling us to be people of praise and prayer, and living signs of his love for all.

LENTEN SACRIFICES

ABSTINENCE

No meat can be eaten. Applies to all Catholics 14+ years old on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays.



FASTING

A limit of one full meatless meal by those 18-59 years old on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

SELF-DENIAL

Voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended on weekdays during Lent.



PRAYER & CHARITY

Can include daily Mass, Scripture study, Stations of the Cross, almsgiving and showing mercy and kindness to others.

¿QUE ES LA CUARESMA?

La Cuaresma es un período de **ayuno, moderación y abnegación**. Es la temporada en la que nos enfocamos a **examinar** nuestros corazones, **confesar** nuestros pecados, y **reflexionar** sobre el significado de la muerte de Cristo.



Este tiempo de ayuno nos abre las puertas del cielo. Acojámosla y recemos para que cuando llegue la Pascua podamos compartir la alegría del Señor resucitado.

¿CUANDO ES?

La cuaresma comienza el **Miércoles de Ceniza** y termina el **Jueves Santo**, que dura **40 días** (sin contar los domingos)

¿QUÉ DEBEMOS HACER DURANTE LA CUARESMA?

1. Apartarnos de nuestros pecados y volver a Dios. Alejarse de hábitos y tendencias que son contrarias a la voluntad de Dios. La Cuaresma es un tiempo de conversión.
2. Abrir nuestros corazones a nuestro Padre, para que podamos vivir con Cristo para Dios. Jesús nos está llamando a ser personas de alabanza y oración, y signos vivos de su amor por todos.
