





WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is a period of fasting, moderation, and self-denial. It is the season in which we focus on examining our hearts, confess our sins, and reflect on the significance of Christ's death.

WHEN IS LENT?

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Thursday. It lasts for 40 days (not counting Sundays).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO DURING LENT?

1. Turn away from our sins and turn back to God.

Detach from habits and tendencies that are contrary to God's will.

Lent is a time of conversion.

2. Open our hearts to our Father, so that we may live with Christ for God. Jesus is calling us to be people of praise and prayer, and living signs of his love for all.

LENTEN SACRIFICES

ABSTINENCE

No meat can be eaten. Applies to all catholics 14+ years old on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays.



FASTING

A limit of one full meatless meal by those 18-59 years old on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.



SELF-DENIAL Voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended on weekdays during Lent.





PRAYER & CHARITY

Can include daily Mass,
Scripture study, Stations of
the Cross, almsgiving and
showing mercy and
kindness to others.

ABNEGACIÓN

Se recomienda hacer actos de abnegación durante las semanas de cuaresma.

Asistir a Misa diario, estudiar las Escrituras, asistir a los vía crucis, dar limosna y mostrar misericordia y bondad a los demás.
