This training is for adults only, ages 18 and older. You will be required to complete a criminal background check as part of the registration process. Please make sure you enter your legal name as it appears on your Government Issued Id.

What is a dogma? Can the Pope's pastoral letters be dogmatic?

Catholic dogma refers to the central and unchangeable teachings of the Catholic Church. These teachings are considered divinely revealed truths, believed by the Church to have been directly communicated by God and entrusted to the Church for preservation and proclamation. Catholic dogmas cover various aspects of faith and moral, including doctrines concerning God, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, the Church, sacraments, moral principles, and the afterlife. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains, "The Church's magisterium exercises the authority it holds from Christ to the fullest extent when it defines dogmas, that is, when it proposes, in a form obliging the Christian people to an irrevocable adherence of faith, truths contained in divine Revelation or also when it proposes, in a definitive way, truths having a necessary connection with these" (CCC 88). Dogmas are doctrines or beliefs that are considered fundamental and unchangeable within the Catholic Church, often declared infallibly by the Pope or an ecumenical council. The pastoral letters of the Pope, often called the Ecclesiastical Letters, typically do not constitute dogmas. Pastoral letters are documents written by the Pope to address specific pastoral issues, offer guidance, encouragement, or instruction to the faithful, or to address particular situations within the Church or society. They may contain teachings and reflections on matters of faith and morals, but they are not typically intended to define dogma. While pastoral letters can certainly contain teachings that align with established dogmas, they themselves do not have the authority to establish dogma.

¿Qué es un dogma? ¿Pueden ser dogmáticas las cartas pastorales del Papa?

El dogma católico se refiere a las enseñanzas centrales e inmutables de la Iglesia Católica. Estas enseñanzas se consideran verdades divinamente reveladas, que la Iglesia cree que han sido comunicadas directamente por Dios y confiadas a la Iglesia para su preservación y proclamación. Los dogmas católicos cubren varios aspectos de la fe y la moral, incluidas las doctrinas sobre Dios, Jesucristo, el Espíritu Santo, la Iglesia, los sacramentos, los principios morales y la vida después de la muerte. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica: "El Magisterio de la Iglesia ejerce en toda su extensión la autoridad que le otorga Cristo cuando define los dogmas, es decir, cuando propone, en una forma que obliga al pueblo cristiano a una adhesión irrevocable de la fe, verdades contenidas en la Revelación divina o también cuando propone, de manera definitiva, verdades que tienen una conexión necesaria con éstas" (CIC 88). Los dogmas son doctrinas o creencias que se consideran fundamentales e inmutables dentro de la Iglesia Católica, a menudo declaradas infaliblemente por el Papa o un concilio ecuménico. Las cartas pastorales del Papa, a menudo llamadas Cartas Eclesiásticas, no suelen constituir dogmas. Las cartas pastorales son documentos escritos por el Papa para abordar temas pastorales específicos, ofrecer orientación, aliento o instrucción a los fieles, o para abordar situaciones particulares dentro de la Iglesia o la sociedad. Pueden contener enseñanzas y reflexiones sobre cuestiones de fe y moral, pero no suelen tener la intención de definir el dogma. Si bien las cartas pastorales ciertamente pueden contener enseñanzas que se alinean con los dogmas establecidos, ellas mismas no tienen la autoridad para establecer dogmas.
