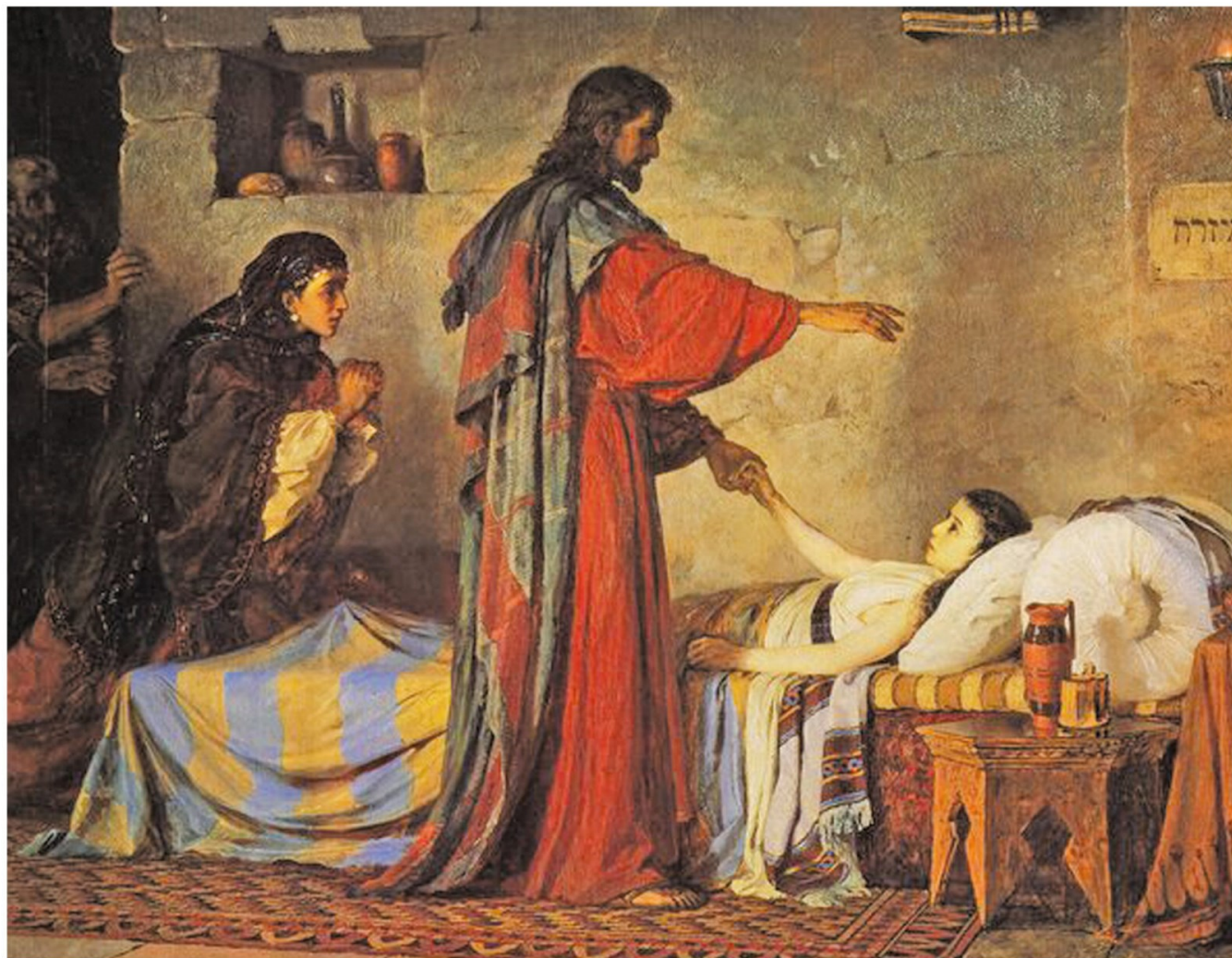

What is an annulment? When is an annulment needed?

An annulment is a legal process from the Catholic Tribunal that declares a marriage null and void, as if it never existed. It's formally called "a declaration of nullity," is an official declaration by the Roman Catholic Church that a marriage did not meet the requirements for validity. Validity means that the desired outcome (in this case, marriage) has actually taken place as recognized by the Church. Unlike a civil divorce, which ends a civil marriage, an annulment states that the sacramental marriage was never valid in the Catholic Church. In order for a Roman Catholic to re-marry it is necessary that a previous marriage be determined and declared invalid by the process of annulment. If a Catholic who has been married and divorced wants to enter into a valid Church marriage, a declaration of nullity is needed. Also, if the person that the Catholic wishes to marry has been married before, that marriage too must be declared invalid by the Catholic Tribunal. In summary, an annulment involves a legal process by the Catholic Church where evidence must be presented to prove that the marriage was invalid in the first place. The specific grounds and procedures for annulment vary by the jurisdiction of the Catholic Tribunal.

¿Qué es una anulación? ¿Cuándo es necesaria una anulación?

Una anulación es un proceso legal del Tribunal Católico que declara nulo un matrimonio, como si nunca hubiera existido. Se denomina formalmente "declaración de nulidad" y es una declaración oficial de la Iglesia Católica Romana de que un matrimonio no cumplía los requisitos de validez. Validez significa que el resultado deseado (en este caso, el matrimonio) ha tenido lugar realmente, tal y como reconoce la Iglesia. A diferencia de un divorcio civil, que pone fin a un matrimonio civil, una anulación declara que el matrimonio sacramental nunca fue válido en la Iglesia Católica. Para que un católico romano pueda volver a casarse es necesario que un matrimonio anterior sea determinado y declarado inválido mediante el proceso de anulación. Si un católico que ha estado casado y se ha divorciado quiere contraer un matrimonio válido por la Iglesia, es necesaria una declaración de nulidad. Además, si la persona con la que el católico desea casarse ha estado casada anteriormente, ese matrimonio también debe ser declarado inválido por el Tribunal Católico. En resumen, una anulación implica un proceso legal por parte de la Iglesia Católica en el que deben presentarse pruebas que demuestren que el matrimonio era inválido en primer lugar. Los motivos y procedimientos específicos para la anulación varían según la jurisdicción del Tribunal Católico.
