Faith First

Genesis 14:18-20 - Mel-

chizedek, king of Salem and priest of God, brought bread and wine and blessed Abram. Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of everything.

Psalm 110 – The Lord declares an eternal priesthood in the

line of Melchizedek, promises victory over enemies, and assures divine authority and power.

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 – Jesus instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper, saying the bread is his body and the cup is the new covenant in his blood, to be done in remembrance of him.

Luke 9:11b-17 - Jesus fed a crowd of five thousand with five loaves and two fish. He blessed and broke the food, distributing it through his disciples. Everyone was satisfied, and twelve baskets of leftovers were collected.

Friday, June 27 – Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

This year marks the 350th anniversary of the revelation of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. On this, our parish's patronal feast day, we

celebrate the love of Jesus for all people. His heart is a symbol of His care, kindness, and mercy. This feast helps us remember how much He gave for us,

on the cross. It is a reminder that His love never ends. He is always there for us, in-


Lord Jesus Christ, we worship you living among us in the sacrament of your body and blood. May we offer to


