

The program will start with a mandatory parent orientation meeting scheduled for Thursday, August, 21, 2025 from 6:30 to 8:00 pm at the parish hall. Attendance is required by an adult family member, since we will need parent's signatures, completed registration packets, and other pertinent information. Preparation for First Holy Communion and Confirmation are included as part of the CFF program. First Holy Communion is a two-year program, and Confirmation is a threeyear program. 
