PRAYER & WORSHIP

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This Sunday, we have a special occasion to celebrate the Solemn Feast of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary of Mt. Carmel at all our weekend Masses. As a parish named in her honor, we have an intimate connection not only as her sons and daughters, but also, in the tradition-



al Carmelite way, as her brothers and sisters. For Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is presented always clothed in the habit of our order. That is to say, she wears the brown scapular over the brown tunic underneath the white cloak of Elijah. For Carmelites, the habit is highly symbolic of both our Holy Father Elijah and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.

On July 16th, Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock in England in 1251 shortly after the First General Chapter held outside of the Holy Land (1247). In Simon's vision, Mary asked that the scapular be worn as a sign and pledge of her protection and love for her brothers. The Carmelites were still shifting from hermits living together to mendicant friars living among the people in the city. The Carmelites saw in the scapular an outward sign of their dedication to Mary who is the ultimate head of the order named in her honor.

We have been blessed here with a long line of Carmelites serving us, including a series of younger brothers ministering as deacons: Michael Joyce, Roberto Mejia and Daniel Gonzalez, all of whom are now ordained priests. We also have been hosts to Bro. Victor Hugo Andrade who is having a parish immersion before returning to Whitefriars Hall in Washington, D.C. to pursue his theology degree. In addition, we have Fr. Jose, Fr. Mario and Fr. David in residence here in Fairfield to enrich our community. And I give thanks to God and to you for allowing me to serve as your pastor these past three years. I consider all of you "Carmelites" whether Friars, Third Order Laity, or just because you wear the brown scapular, or even belong to OLMC. We are a family in the church in the contemplative and prophetic spirits of Mary and Elijah - how can we go wrong? How can we not be filled with a jealous zeal for the Lord God of Hosts as with joy at being Our Lady's own.

As we gather to celebrate the brightest star of the sea, may we have smooth sailing, like the early Carmelites toward that other shore - our heavenly homeland.
