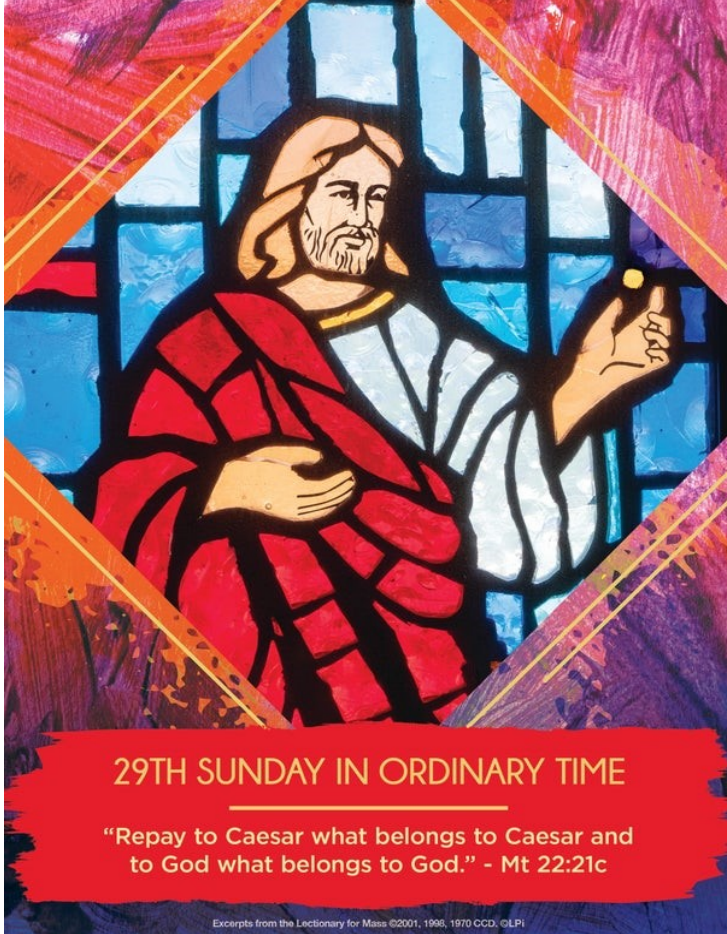

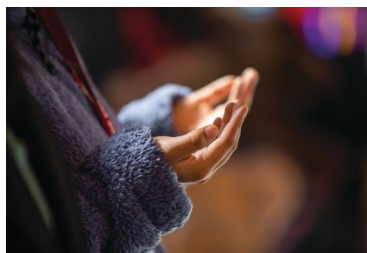

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This weekend is the Annual Finance Glance, that is a brief overview of the state of the parish regarding our use and management of the temporal goods entrusted to us. Let us be mindful that our church building will be 20 years old as

of Dec. 8th. How could we ever imagine a more beautiful church and facilities than ours? This testifies to the vibrancy and generosity of all our current and past members. We are truly blessed by God.

The fiscal year-end report demonstrates that we are recovering well from the Covid pandemic and subsequent restrictions on worship and activities. Most importantly, we were able to keep all of our employees, which is our biggest expense as well as our greatest asset. When I started as pastor, in July of 2020, the parish was in debt to the tune of \$514,819 due to Diocesan loans and obligations - the Capital One Campaign and the solar, fence, and COVID loans. Our debt now is \$57,887.36. The last loan to pay off is for the church and dome solar panels, which provide their own benefit when paying our PG&E bill. If all goes well, we will be debt-free very soon for the first time in anyone's memory. We are in the process now of resurfacing and restriping our parking lot for the anticipated cost of \$71k, which is being paid directly from the Capital Improvements fund. Some of the projects completed during my three years as pastor were new roofs on our two priories (\$49,450), church, dome, and both priories repainted (\$126,960), concrete leveling in the courtyard (\$14,830), church and dome lights replaced with LED (\$31,350), church sound system replaced (\$28,429), tree removal (\$25,800) and the recarpeting of the second floor hallways in the dome (\$8,687.88). Ongoing works in progress: HVAC repairs (approx. \$13k), cleaning the church (\$4,377), refinishing the pews, installing more security cameras and re-landscaping for a drier environment. All of these projects are made possible in large part due to your support of the first Sunday of the month Capital Improvements Fund collection. Thank you for supporting our parish by your regular tithing and sacrifices. Remember also, how your giving to the Annual Catholic Appeal helps so many, including our own parish by the 25% rebate, which so far this year is over \$20,000.

We also have not forgotten about serving the poor in our neighborhood. We continue to give a portion of our collection plate to St. Vincent de Paul for rent, utility, financial and food assistance. Additionally, we collected \$17,800 for the Carmelite Missions, as well as supporting the numerous, but worthy, Diocesan second collections throughout the year. We also have savings of \$14,000 secured with the Catholic Foundation.

A copy of the financial report is available in the office for interested parishioners to view.

As with any finance glance, the bottom line is the big takeaway. One can only conclude that we are in a very good place and are able to do the things that need doing because of your great love for Our Lady of Mt Carmel and your outstanding generosity and sacrifices. Keep up the great work! May God bless you many times over for all the good that you do.

Since 1973, the year the Supreme Court legalized abortion nationwide in Roe v. Wade, the month of October has been set aside by the U.S. bishops as a time to focus on protecting God's precious gift of human life. A great many prayers, sacrifices, and good works are still desperately needed to transform a culture of death into a culture of life. While ending legalized abortion remains our preeminent priority, the most immediate way to save babies and mothers from abortion is to thoroughly surround mothers in need with lifegiving support and personal accompaniment.
